## Campus Veteran Resource Center Grant Program Request for Grant Proposals

**Issued: April 29, 2020 | Proposals Due: June 17, 2020 by 11:59 pm**

To All Oregon Community Colleges, Public Universities and Interested Parties.

The Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) is pleased to issue the current Request for Grant Proposals (RFGP) for the Campus Veteran Resource Center Grant Program. The deadline for submitting grant proposals is June 17, 2020 by 11:59 pm. Only Oregon community colleges and public universities are eligible to apply for this grant.

The 2019 Oregon State Legislature passed Senate Bill 35, establishing a continuation of up to \$1 million grant program to expand campus veteran resource centers on the campuses of Oregon community colleges and public universities. The purpose of the Campus Veteran Resource Center Grant Program ("CVRC Grant Program") is to augment existing campus programs that help veterans successfully transition from military service to college life, succeed in college and complete educational goals, and then transition from college to the workforce and the community.

The bill requires ODVA to develop and implement the CRVC Grant Program and award multiple one-time grants on a competitive basis. Each community college and public university may submit only one grant proposal, regardless of the number of campuses. A grant proposal may include more than one project; however, the proposal must describe the goals, objectives, outcome measures and requested award amount for each project.

The maximum grant award is \$100,000, regardless of the number of campuses a school has. Grant funds must be spent during the funding period. This is a reimbursement grant, and as such, reimbursement claims will need to be submitted to receive funds.

The Request for Grant Proposals are available on the [ODVA website](#). In addition, ODVA will email an invitation to all Oregon community colleges and public universities. All submissions will be made via a secure upload at the ODVA website.
