Respective PSAP:

This is a financial update of the 9-1-1 program for the distribution of the second quarter 2016 emergency communications tax revenues. These tax revenues are collected from customers during the third quarter of 2016 (July through September 2016) by the phone companies. The phone companies pay the collected taxes to Department of Revenue (DOR) and those taxes are then transferred to Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management (OEM) during the period of October through December 2016.

During the quarter beginning October 1 through December 31, 2016, \$10,744,746 in tax revenues were received by the department. From these receipts, \$0 was paid to the Oregon Department of Revenue for collection and processing costs. Our administrative costs incurred for the past quarter was \$557,148. The advance withholding of administrative costs will be \$600,000 less the difference between the estimate and actuals for last quarter less any adjustments or \$516,807. The contribution to the 35% Enhanced Subaccount will be \$3,760,661. The remainder, approximately \$6.467 million, will be distributed to the PSAPs as prescribed by Oregon Revised Statute 403.240 (9).
