As of May 7, 2025 REAL ID is required to board domestic flights and access federal facilities.

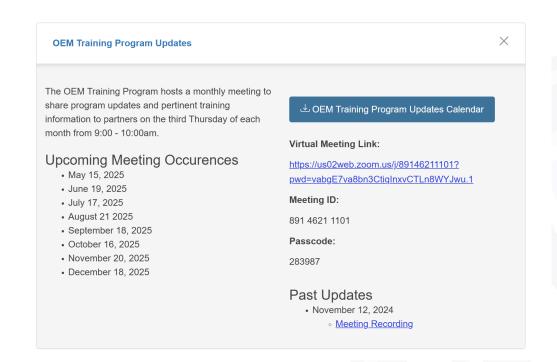

Training Travel Reimbursement Project

- Reimbursements must be directly to your agency
- Must receive approval before the first day of travel from OEM for reimbursement (applications must be submitted 30 days before)

<u>Training Travel Reimbursement Scholarship</u>

The Oregon Emergency Management Training Program (OEM Training) has been awarded funding from the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) to support training travel expenses equitably to support local training delivery needs in underserved locations. The Training Travel Scholarship has a limited funding stream, and funds will be distributed based on merit until all funds have been exhausted.

 - Identify their primary EOC position
 - Make progress towards completing the skillsets associated with that position based on the crosswalk below
- Anything else is encouraged professional development, but is not required by SQS, such as:
 - Completion of additional EOC skillsets
 - Completion of Type-3 Position Task Books
