# OEM Training Program Summer Outlook

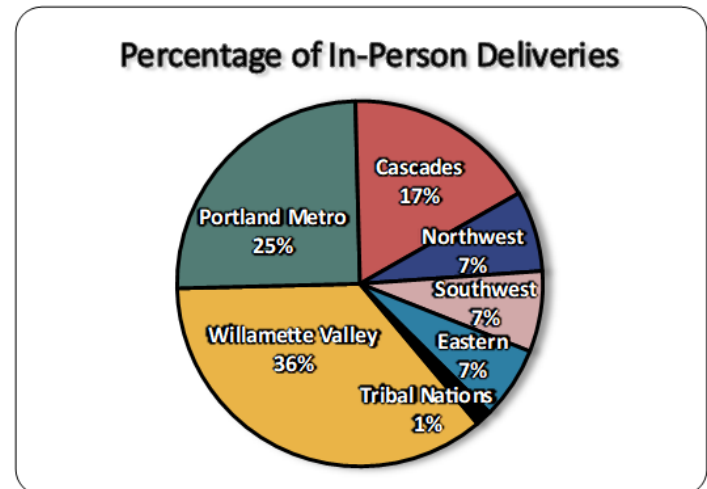
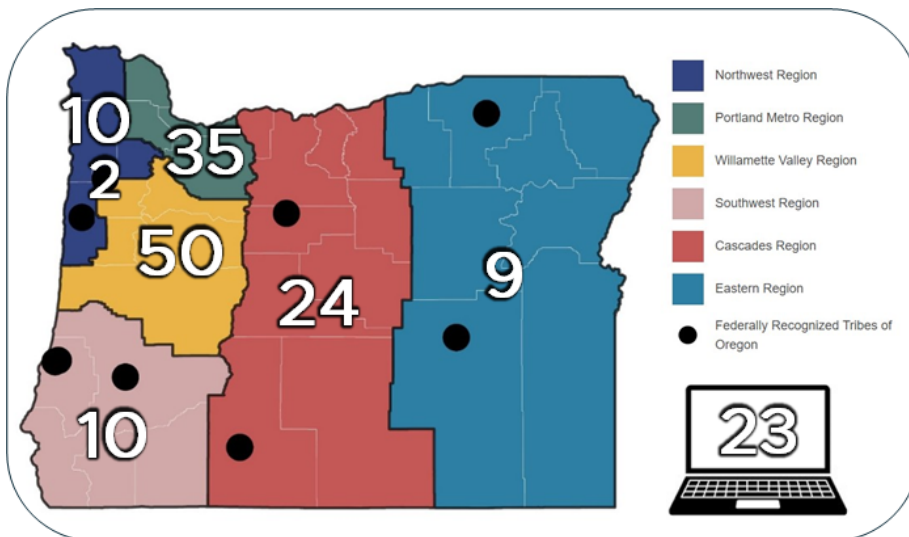
- July-August has very few training deliveries
- Allows us to focus on:
  - Program Management
  - Catch up
  - Finalizing IPP
  - Finalizing Oregon Prepared AAR
  - FY25 Program Reporting
  - Planning for Fall '25 through Spring '26
- Oregon Prepared Kickoff in August
- Internal ECC Training development and activation



# FY24 (7/1/2024 – 6/30/2025) Review

- 163 trainings delivered, a 19% increase from FY23
- 103 supported by the OEM Training Program and 60 hosted by OEM.
- 2606.8 hours of instruction to 2578 students
- 77 instructors from 41 different organizations.

## O-305 Updates

- NFA course O-305 type 3 IMT all hazard training
- \$25K per course 5 days 3 instructors
- Train the trainer N-310 delivery in October
  - NFA is being critical of applicants
  - Limited spots
  - Looking for experienced instructors with strong type 3 background
  - Looking for people that would be willing to teach in different locations in Oregon.
- We have a list started of potential students, if interested reach out
- After taking 310, you must co-instruct twice to become a primary instructor



# State Qualification System

- HR open until June 1, 2026
  - To use experience from 2020 Labor Day Fires/Covid-19, applications must be submitted before 12/31/2025)
- You can only submit for one position per application packet
