Attrition (No Shows and Late Cancellations)

Historical Recognition

As Oregon implements NQS to support the credentialing of Incident Command System (ICS) and Emergency Operations Center (EOC) personnel, it recognizes the importance of the valuable experience these personnel have acquired over the years.

To support the implementation, the Oregon Statewide Qualification System will accept applications for historical recognition in Incident Management positions and Emergency Operations Center skillsets from June 1, 2024, to June 1, 2026. Applications for historical recognition will not be accepted after that period.

The historical recognition process is a separate and distinct process from reciprocity to other qualification systems like the National Wildland Coordinating Group (NWCG) and United State Coast Guard (USCG).

Oregon SQS Historic Recognition Process

- Process and Guidance:
 - Application/Cover Sheet (Narrative)
 - Experience Tracker
 - Letter of recommendation (highly recommended)
 - Comes from person that witnessed you in the position
 - Training Education
 - E/L/K course for position specific course.
 - O-305 All Hazard Type 3 IMT training course
 - Supporting documentation
 - IAP's identifying you in the position
 - ICS-225 evaluations from an event.
- Checklists and PTB's are not required for HR
- Finished HR application packets submitted to oem.training@oem.oregon.gov
