### Course Description:

Learn about, complete and utilize most common Incident Command System (ICS) forms. The course will prepare you to work with the ICS Forms used in the Incident Command Planning process to assist in developing an Incident Action Plan (IAP). You will be introduced to the forms and will practice how to develop and write effective objectives to manage an expanding all-hazards incident. Participants will learn and experience the benefits of using the forms responding to emergencies or managing planned events.

### Course Objectives

- Identify the ICS forms that serve as the basis for an IAP and/or EOC-AP.
- Describe the IAP and EOC-AP development process.
- Describe how resource needs are identified during the planning process.
- Discuss the operational period planning cycle (Planning P) diagram.
- Provide an example of an incident objective to be considered during planning.
