Oregon State Qualifications System

- Historical Recognition Evaluation Process:
 - Application comes in and we wait until we have at least 6.
 - 4 person QRB activated (When they have time)
 - Review window is 2-3 weeks
 - End of review window, QRB have questions or require more documentation
 - OEM Training reaches out to the applicant
 - Applicant takes a couple days to a couple weeks to get back
 - QRB reviews and decides if that is sufficient to make endorsement
 - QRB may request interview, OEM training sets interview with QRB and applicant which may take a couple weeks.
 - All successful applicants go to Deputy Director for signature. Average turnaround for signature is 1 week.



Oregon State Qualifications System

Historical Recognition Period ends 6/1/2026

- Applications must be in before close of business that day to be considered.
- After June 1st, all applicants must have type 3 PTB or EOC Skillset checklist book completed and part of their submission.
- We are anticipating a large surge of applicants over the next 2 weeks.

Applications should have:

- At least 1 real world activation
- At least 3 different events (can use exercise, with proper documentation)
- Narrative describing what you did in the position and the tasks that you were assigned.
- Documentation evidence to back up your narrative
- Training certificates consistent with the position or skillsets you are applying for. Type 3 positions require PSC course (900 level) along with O-305.
