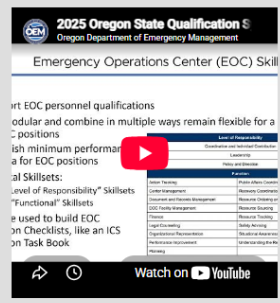

The first edition of the Oregon State Qualification System Guidance was published in May 2024. The historical recognition period will end June 2026.

Adoption of the Oregon SQS is required for recipients of the [Emergency Management Performance Grant \(EMPG\)](#) and voluntary for all other entities.

Fiscal Year Training Review

- The OEM Training Program hosted 49 and supported 99 training deliveries, totaling 148 deliveries and exceeding the number planned for the year in the IPP.
- These courses total more than 2,276 hours of instruction to 2,334 students, conducted by 91 OEM-credentialed or support instructors from 43 different organizations.
