



# OREGON OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

**UPDATE: April 20, 2022; 10:00am**

**FEMA has recently projected that the FY2022 Notice of Funding for the Non-Profit Security Grant Program will be released on May 13, 2022. It is expected that all applications will need to be reviewed and submitted by the OEM by mid-June, giving applicants a very short time to submit their project applications. OEM is adjusting our timetable to align with FEMA's changes.**

On March 10, 2022 Congress passed the appropriations bill necessary to fund the Non-profit Security Grant Program (NSGP). Once the bill becomes law, with the President's signature, FEMA will have 60 days to produce a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the 2022 NSGP program.

In preparation for the forthcoming NOFO, Oregon as the State Administrative Agency (SAA) is opening up an registration period for you to sign up to apply, once the NOFO is release.

For the FY22 NSGP program, there will be two steps to apply.

1) Register to apply by using this link: <https://forms.office.com/g/M13V6p2SGC>

This registration tool will provide OEM with the information needed to set up your application portal, in Basecamp, where you will submit your application documents.

2) submission of application documents into Basecamp.

Once the NOFO has been released and FEMA provides OEM with the application forms, those forms will be stored in your Basecamp profile for you to download, complete, then upload back into Basecamp.

The Deadline to register for the FY22 NSGP application (step 1) is 11:59pm Pacific DST on Friday [~~June 10~~] **May 6, 2022.**

The deadline to apply through basecamp (step 2) will be determined with the release of the NOFO. If you have registered to apply, we will notify of the updated deadline to apply, when we have that information.
