2023

- Increased state participation

- Successful FMA subapplications
- Successful FEMA DTA use

2024

- Reduced funding levels, applicant award ceiling of \$150m
- Increasing national competition
- Pre-NOFO preapplication round
- Increased project \$ asks, concentration in water infrastructure
- Underutilized FEMA Incentives

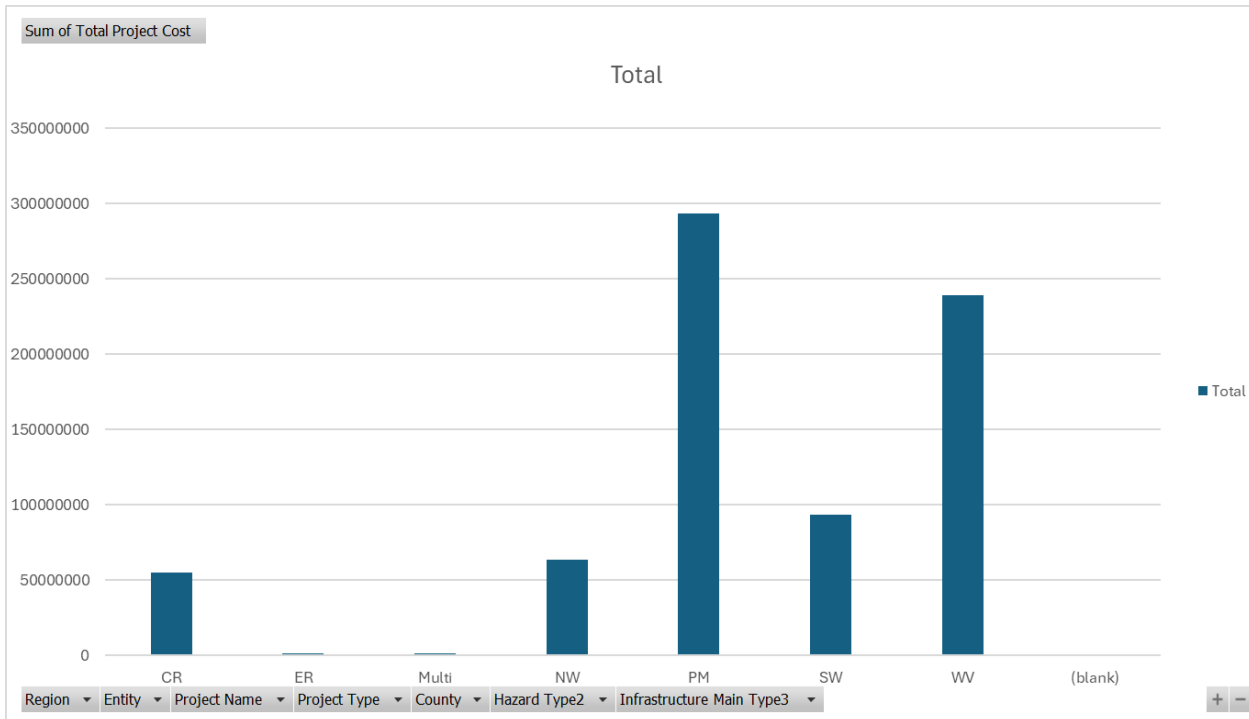
