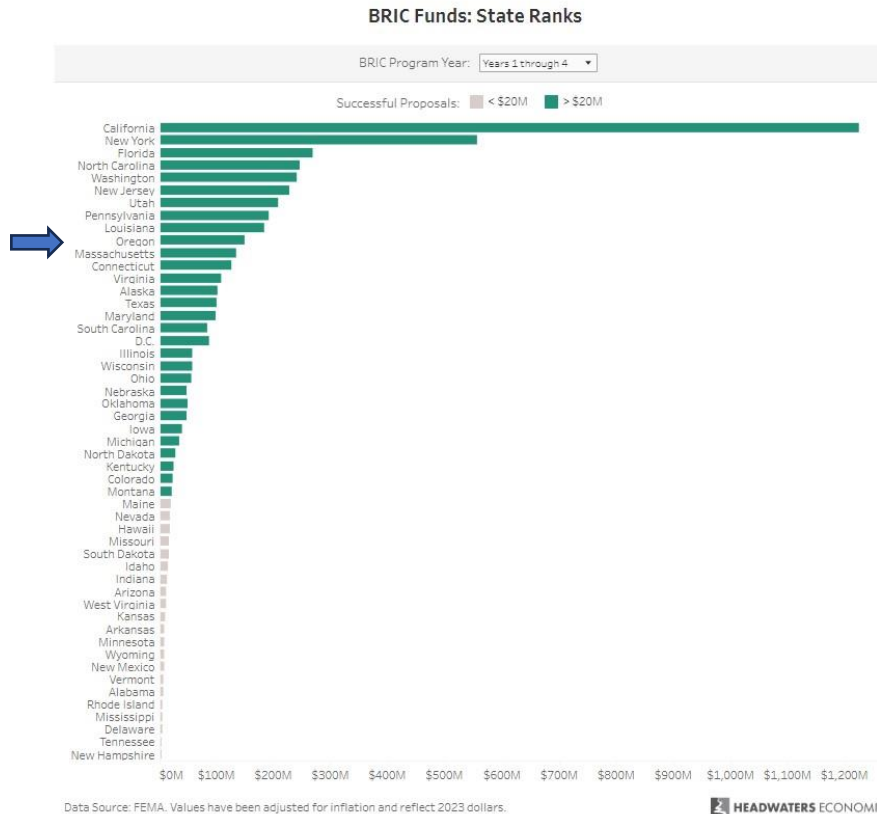




HMA Non-Disaster



BRIC/FMA 4 Years 2020-2023

- Oregon is in the top 10 states for BRIC/FMA awards
- In 2022 Oregon had its highest federal funding award level, placing the state at #4 nationally for that fiscal year
- Focus of submittals from 2021 forward continues to be in infrastructure projects

- Consistent level of submittals
- Increased \$ asks concentrated in water infrastructure
- Underutilized FEMA Incentives
- Focus on Qualitative Criteria development across project submittals
