Period of Performance (POP) Extension Requests

1st POP extension request

- Goes to FEMA Region to review and approve
- Region can only approve for one year
- Turn around time fast

2nd POP extension request

- Goes to FEMA headquarters for review and approval
- Headquarters Can approve for multiple years
- Turn around time longer
