- WHEREAS:** The safety and resilience of Oregonians depend on our collective understanding of how to prepare for earthquakes and other natural disasters; and
- WHEREAS:** Practicing emergency drills significantly reduces risk and saves lives; and
- WHEREAS:** On October 16, 2025, Oregonians will join millions around the world in observing International ShakeOut Day by participating in earthquake safety drills at 10:16 a.m., demonstrating our statewide commitment to disaster readiness; and
- WHEREAS:** The Great Oregon ShakeOut encourages individuals, schools, businesses, and communities across our state to register their drills, participate at times that work for them, and include remote participants via video conferencing to expand the reach of this lifesaving initiative; and
- WHEREAS:** The weekend following the ShakeOut, October 17-19, 2025, is marked as the Great Oregon Camp-In, which invites households to spend dedicated time practicing essential activities as if a major disaster has occurred, helping build confidence and foster a culture of preparedness throughout Oregon.
