## BRIC FY2024–FY2025 NOFO Frequently Asked Questions

### What is being announced?

FEMA has re-released the **Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) FY2024–FY2025 Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)**. OEM is sharing this update with subapplicants and outlining next steps for participation.

### Is the Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) FY2024 NOFO included?

No. FMA remains pending and is not part of this announcement.

### Is Direct Technical Assistance available?

No. FEMA has not included Direct Technical Assistance in this NOFO.

### What happens to the BRIC FY2024 subapplications already submitted?

Existing FY2024 subapplications are in pending-submittal status in FEMAGO. Subapplicants must review the revised NOFO, determine whether revisions are needed or feasible, and update their subapplications accordingly.

### What if a FY2024 subapplicant is no longer eligible or cannot revise their application?

They should request withdrawal by emailing [oem.hazardmitigation@oem.oregon.gov](mailto:oem.hazardmitigation@oem.oregon.gov) with the subject line "Subapplication Withdrawal Request BRIC FY2024-FY2025."

### Are FY2024 subapplications required to move to the FY2025 module in FEMAGO?

Some subapplicants may need to manually transfer their subapplication. OEM is awaiting clarification from FEMA and will provide instructions directly to affected subapplicants.

## Who must submit a pre-application?

Any organization seeking to participate in BRIC FY2025 must submit a pre-application to OEM. The deadline is 5 p.m. PST Friday, April 24, 2026.

## How long does FEMAGO registration take?

Registration may take up to four weeks because it requires steps in Login.gov and SAM.gov. All subapplicants must be registered by May 29, 2026.

## What types of projects are eligible?

Eligible activities include cost-effective infrastructure and construction projects that reduce natural hazard risks. Projects must have at least 30 percent design. Only capability and capacity-building activities directly tied to infrastructure resilience are eligible.

## What activities are no longer eligible?

### *Ineligible activities now include:*

- Hazard mitigation plan development or updates
- Scoping that is not tied to a specific infrastructure project
- Phased construction projects

## What are the key dates?

- **April 2, 2026:** OEM NOFO webinar (tentative)
- **April 24, 2026:** FY2025 pre-application deadline
- **May 8, 2026:** OEM sends invitation notifications
- **May 29, 2026:** FEMAGO registration deadline
- **July 1, 2026, 5 p.m.:** Subapplication submission deadline
- **July 23, 2026, noon:** OEM's deadline to submit subapplications in FEMAGO
