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RSF 1 – Community Assistance

Mission: The mission of Recovery Support Function (RSF) 1 Community Assistance is to integrate federal, state and non-governmental resources to assist planning and capacity building at the local (e.g., city/county/special district) and Tribal government level before, during and after disasters.

Scope:

Activities included within the scope of RSF 1 are:

- Support the restoration and revitalization of cities, counties and tribal economies after a disaster.
- Identify opportunities that allow businesses and people to return to the impacted areas.
- Build partnerships with federal, state, local, tribal and non-governmental partners prior to emergencies to increase the level of recovery support and economic resiliency.

RSF 2 – Economic Recovery

Mission: The mission of Recovery Support Function (RSF) 2 Economic Recovery is to integrate the expertise of state agencies to facilitate the efforts of local (e.g., city and county) governments and Tribal governments to sustain and rebuild businesses and to develop economic opportunities that result in sustainable and economically resilient communities after natural and human-caused disasters.

Scope:

Activities included within the scope of RSF 2 are:

- Assisting with the facilitation between Recovery Support Functions.
- Reinforcing partnerships between Federal, State, Tribal Nations, and local governments before, during and after disasters.
- Building community capacity, understanding recovery priorities and providing assistance around resiliency and long-term recovery.
- Designating a regional recovery liaison that can help elevate community recovery priorities and needs.
- Assisting counties/tribal governments navigate the complexities of federal programs such as FEMA Individual Assistance, Public Assistance and Mitigation (e.g. 404/406).

RSF 3 – Health Services

Mission: The mission of Recovery Support Function (RSF) 3 Health Services is to support locally led recovery efforts to prepare and restore public health, health care, human services and behavioral health networks to promote the resilience, health and well-being of affected individuals and communities in accordance with state and federal laws.

Scope:

Activities included within the scope of RSF 3 are:

- Support restoration of healthcare systems and services.
- Conduct assessments of a disaster's impacts on local, tribal, and statewide public health and on local and tribal health care delivery systems.
- Provide post-disaster behavioral health guidance to impacted communities.
- Monitor and regulate drinking water quality.
- Conduct, facilitate, and coordinate ongoing public health and health care system recovery activities.

RSF 4 – Human Services

Mission: The mission of Recovery Support Function (RSF) 4 Human Services is to support Oregon’s diverse local (city and county) and Tribal governments with a focus on restoring essential human services following a disaster.

Scope:

Activities included within the scope of RSF 4 are:

- Identify and restore basic social services functions including services for populations with access and functional needs.
- Effective January 2027, administer the State Individual Assistance Program, when directed, to address disaster-related unmet needs.
- Support whole community recovery programs for individuals and families affected by a disaster to promote a more effective and rapid recovery effort.

RSF 5 – Disaster Housing

Mission: The mission of Recovery Support Function (RSF) 5 Disaster Housing is to support intermediate- and long-term housing solutions and to rehabilitate and reconstruct destroyed and damaged housing. The coordination of resources at all levels of government is critical when addressing disaster recovery housing issues and ensuring a whole-community approach to recovery. The mission prioritizes equity, accessibility, and collaboration with local organizations to address the unique risks and needs of Oregon's diverse communities.

Scope:

Activities included within the scope of RSF 5 are:

- Monitor intermediate housing efforts conducted by RSF 4 and provide technical assistance as needed. Intermediate housing solutions are intended to cover the gap between emergency sheltering and permanent housing, generally providing living conditions for self-sustainability, including access to prepared food, as well as keeping people in their community after a disaster.
- Prioritizing long-term sustainability, community engagement, and social equity in rebuilding efforts.
- Ongoing assessment of community needs and establishment of recovery strategies to build resilient communities.
- Providing resources to promote long-term housing solutions, including home ownership.
- Addressing pets and service animals in state housing strategies.

RSF 6 – Infrastructure Systems

Mission: The mission of Recovery Support Function (RSF) 6 Infrastructure Systems is to provide support to local and Tribal governments for the rehabilitation and reconstruction of impacted infrastructure systems through coordinated delivery of state and federal resources while supporting long-term infrastructure mitigation that highlights the use of new, accessible and permanently resilient infrastructure systems.

Scope:

Activities included within the scope of RSF 6 are:

RSF 7 – Natural and Cultural Resources

Mission: The mission of Recovery Support Function (RSF) 7 Natural and Cultural Resources (NCR) is to integrate federal and state resources and capabilities to support county, city and Tribal governments in addressing long-term recovery and resiliency needs for natural and cultural resources following disasters. The mission aims to preserve, conserve, rehabilitate and restore natural, cultural and historic properties and resources in alignment with post-disaster community priorities and in compliance with environmental laws.

Scope:

Activities included within the scope of RSF 7 are:

- With a respectful focus on Tribal sacred geography; this includes areas of traditional harvesting, stewardship of traditional gathering areas, areas of cultural practices and some Treaty reserved gathering areas.
- Coordinate with Tribes to activate protocols for maintaining safekeeping of cultural resources before, during, and after emergencies.
- The scope of Cultural Resources encompasses documentation and physical protection to ensure history is not erased in a disaster. State agencies within NCR RSF may look for opportunities to protect these resources before, during and after a disaster.
