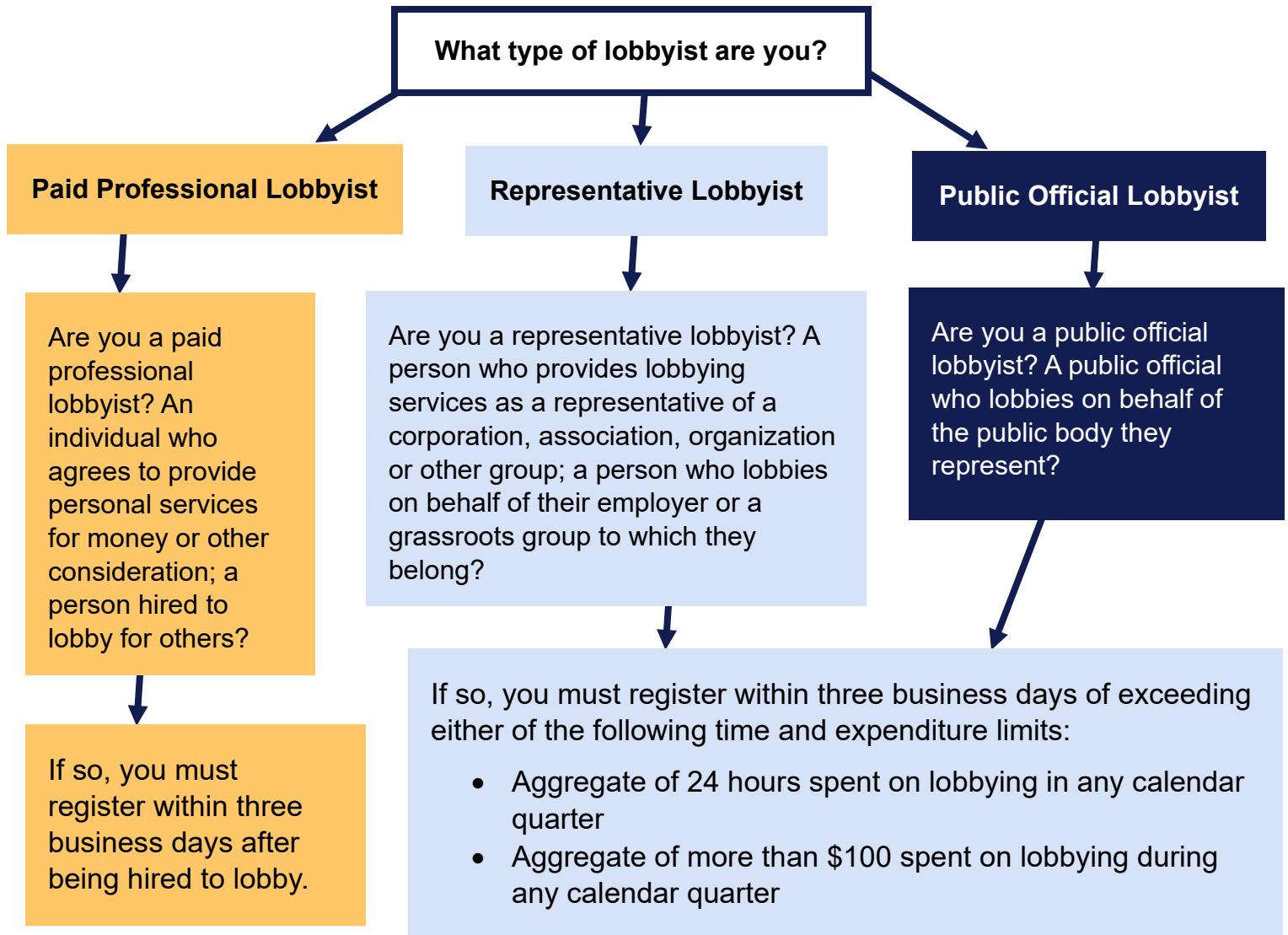


Lobbyist Registration Flowchart

Lobbying is the influence or attempt to influence legislative action through oral or written communication with legislative officials, solicitation of executive officials or other persons to influence or attempt to influence legislative action or attempt to obtain the goodwill of legislative officials. Do you engage in lobbying? If so....



You are not required to register if you are any of the following (see exceptions set forth in ORS 171.735):

- News media who directly or indirectly urge legislative action.
- Individuals who receive no payment for lobbying, who limit lobbying to formal testimony before public sessions of committees or state agency public hearings, and who, when testifying, register an appearance in the records of committees or agencies.
- Legislative officials acting in an official capacity.
- The Governor or any of the other senior level public officials identified in ORS 171.735(5).
