Defendant appeared in person and was not in custody. The court determined that the defendant was indigent for purposes of court-appointed counsel, and the court appointed counsel for the defendant. The defendant was represented by Attorney(s) Ryan Colvin Connell, OSB Number 103603. Plaintiff appeared by and through Attorney(s) JODIE ANNE BURETA, OSB Number 032776. The court finds the defendant to be indigent for the purposes of appeal. Defendant knowingly waived two day waiting period before sentencing.

COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment

Count number 1, Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment, 165.692, Felony Class C, committed on or between 05/01/2017 and 05/31/2017. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/23/2017.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Downward Durational Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

- Stipulation of Parties

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Pay fines, restitution and other fees ordered by the Court. Set up payment plan with Tillamook County Circuit Court by October 23, 2017.
- Keep the Court advised of current mailing address, street address, and telephone number. Notify the Court in writing of any change in address or telephone number within 10 days of change.
- Obey all municipal, county, state and federal laws and ordinances.
- Perform 40 hours of community service at not less than eight hours per month. Written proof of hours completed to be submitted to the Court monthly, beginning December 1, 2017. Pay required fees. Community service work is work done without pay and arranged through a non-profit organization or public entity.
- Shall not work for any entity that receives medicare.
- Apply for misdemeanor treatment within 30 days prior to the end of probation, which may be allowed upon successful completion.

Statutory Provisions

Defendant is ordered to submit blood or buccal sample and thumbprint pursuant to ORS 137.076.

Monetary Terms

Defendant shall be required to pay the following amounts on this count:

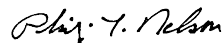
