The defendant was represented by Attorney(s) Nathan G Law, OSB Number 104340. Plaintiff appeared by and through Attorney(s) MELISSA M CHUREAU, OSB Number 022726. Defendant knowingly waived two day waiting period before sentencing.

COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment

Count number 1, Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment, 165.692, Felony Class C, committed on or between 07/23/2017 and 08/04/2017. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 01/16/2018.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 3 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)):

Defendant shall:

- You must complete 80 hours of community service at the direction and approval of the community service office by July 16, 2018. Further, you shall pay \$40.00 community service fee as required.
- Defendant may not be employed as a health or dependent care provider in any capacity with the exception of caring for defendant's own minor children.
- The State does not object to misdemeanor treatment of this conviction upon successful completion of probation.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 2 day(s). Defendant is to report to Washington County Jail by 01/26/2018 at 7:00 PM. If defendant FTA's for jail, 10 days with no programs is imposed. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.
