It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment

Count number 1, Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment, 165.692, Felony Class C, committed on or between 07/23/2017 and 08/04/2017. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 01/02/2018.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is H.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 3 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Defendant shall not have employment of a care provider, representative, fiduciary or power of attorney
- All court ordered fines and fees, excluding cases in which compensatory fines or restitution have been ordered, are due in full within 30 days unless a payment plan is established with the clerk of the court. If compensatory fines or restitution are ordered, all financial obligations in the case must be paid in full 60 days prior to the expiration of probation, unless otherwise ordered. Payment plans include previously ordered amounts. The laws allow fees to recover administrative and collection costs to be automatically added and collected without further notice to you or action by the court, when the court has to establish a payment account, refer a matter for collection, or send DMV a suspension notice.

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 2 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 3 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)):
Defendant shall:

- Defendant shall not have employment of a care provider, representative, fiduciary or power of attorney
- All court ordered fines and fees, excluding cases in which compensatory fines or restitution have been ordered, are due in full within 30 days unless a payment plan is established with the clerk of the court. If compensatory fines or restitution are ordered, all financial obligations in the case must be paid in full 60 days prior to the expiration of probation, unless otherwise ordered. Payment plans include previously ordered amounts.
