The defendant was represented by Attorney(s) JOAN DEMAREST, OSB Number 982128. Plaintiff appeared by and through Attorney(s) MELISSA M CHUREAU, OSB Number 022726. Defendant knowingly waived two day waiting period before sentencing.

COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment

Count number 1, Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment, 165.692, Felony Class C, committed on or between 09/30/2016 and 10/03/2016. Conviction is based upon a No Contest Plea on 04/12/2017.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 36 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)):
Defendant shall:

- Report to the Department of Corrections at 118 2nd Ave SE, Suite F, Albany, OR immediately after pronouncement of this sentence (or within 72 hours after release from jail).
- Report to the Linn County Jail for fingerprinting by 5 pm on 04/19/17.
- No employment providing health or other dependent care or any in-home services whether by private pay or payment directly or indirectly with Medicaid or Medicare funds, or acting as any person's Power of Attorney or representative in any capacity.
- Report immediately, or within 72 hours after release from custody, to the Linn County Civil Sheriff's Office, located on the third floor of the Linn County Courthouse, and serve 3 days of Compensatory Service (e.g., community service, electronic home detention, work crew, day treatment center, jail).
NOTE: You must pay a fee of \$20 directly to the Linn County Civil Sheriff's Office to participate in any form of Compensatory Service. Work for the Gleaners previously completed will satisfy this condition with proper documentation provided to the State.

Statutory Provisions

Defendant is ordered to submit blood or buccal sample and thumbprint pursuant to ORS 137.076.

Defendant shall be required to pay the following amounts on this count:
