It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Criminal Mistreatment in the First Degree

Count number 1, Criminal Mistreatment in the First Degree, 163.205, Felony Class C, committed on or about 04/15/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 03/29/2016.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 1 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 36 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation: Defendant is ordered to pay a supervision fee.

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)):
Defendant shall:

- * Report to Deschutes County Community Corrections, Parole and Probation, 63360 Britta Street Bldg.# 2 Bend, Oregon 97701, no later than 03/29/16 at 4:00 p.m., and report thereafter as directed by defendant's probation officer.

Defendant may request transfer to bench probation upon successful completion of probation conditions.

- Serve 7 days on electronic GPS monitor.
- Transfer interest in 62410 Erickson Road, Bend, Oregon, to High Desert Wildlife Rescue.
- Defendant is not to be compensated with Medicaid or Medicare dollars for care provided.

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 3 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 36 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)):
Defendant shall:

- Obey all municipal, county, state and federal laws.
- * Report to Deschutes County Community Corrections, Parole and Probation, 63360 Britta Street Bldg.# 2 Bend, Oregon 97701, no later than 03/29/16 at 4:00 p.m., and report thereafter as directed by defendant's probation officer.

Defendant may request transfer to bench probation upon successful completion of probation conditions.

- Serve 7 days electronic GPS monitor, concurrent with Count 1.
- Transfer interest in 62410 Erickson Road, Bend, Oregon, to High Desert Wildlife Rescue.
- Defendant is not to be compensated with Medicaid or Medicare dollars for care provided.
- \$200 conviction fee suspended.

Statutory Provisions

Defendant is ordered to submit blood or buccal sample and thumbprint pursuant to ORS 137.076.

COUNTS DISPOSED WITH NO CONVICTION

Count # 2, Criminal Mistreatment in the Second Degree is Dismissed.

Count # 4, Tax Evasion is Dismissed.
