Count 1 : Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment

Count number 1, Making a False Claim for Health Care Payment, 165.692, Felony Class C, committed on or between 10/17/2016 and 12/01/2016. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 04/17/2018.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

- * Complete 100 hour(s) community work service. Must complete at a rate of no less than 5 hours per month with the first 5 being due at the end of June, 2018.
- After all requirements are met and restitution is paid in full, Defendant may request early termination of probation.
- Defendant may not be employed with any agency for which compensation is paid through Medicare and Medicaid.
