

## Health Care Workforce Reporting Program Frequently Asked Questions

*Q. What datasets are available?*

A. Data collection began in 2009 for seven health licensing boards. An additional 10 licensing boards began mandatory collection in 2016. Complete data sets for the newly added boards will be available in 2017 or 2018 depending on their licensing cycle. Email [wkfc.admin@state.or.us](mailto:wkfc.admin@state.or.us) to obtain the current list of available datasets.

*Q. What is included in the public use data files?*

A. Not all active licensees complete the workforce survey. Only licensees who are renewing their license complete it. Each health licensing Board promulgates its own rules pertaining to when license-holders must renew their licenses. Survey data includes data on basic demographics, languages spoken, education, practice settings and hours worked, and specialties. *Q. What is the cost for data?*

A. The cost is \$100 for each occupational dataset.

*Q. Do you take credit cards?*

A. Unfortunately we do not. We can only accept check or money order. Please make checks out to Oregon Health Authority and include 'Attn: HWRP' in memo line.

*Q. How can I access identifiable data?*

A. Identifiable data may not be released.

*Q. Can I get custom datasets from Oregon?*

A. Generally speaking, no. The state of Oregon provides public use data sets. If you are in need of a custom dataset, inquire by emailing [wkfc.admin@state.or.us](mailto:wkfc.admin@state.or.us). Custom datasets may require an additional cost.
