Proposed Community Benefit Minimum Spending Floor Notification

This notice is to inform you that the Oregon Health Authority has calculated and proposed a Community Benefit Minimum Spending Floor for Providence Health System and its affiliated clinics as designated on the CBR-3 form:

- o Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital
- o Providence Medford Medical Center
- Providence Milwaukie Hospital
- Providence Newberg Medical Center
- o Providence Portland medical Center
- o Providence Seaside Hospital
- Providence St. Vincent Medical Center
- o Providence Willamette Falls Medical Center
- o PMG North 610
- o PMG South 611
- o Clinical Programs 612

The Oregon Health Authority has proposed a minimum spending floor of

- \$283,557,621 for fiscal year 2024, and
- \$292,975,344 for fiscal year 2025.

Your previous spending floors were \$259,450,555 for fiscal year 2022 and \$263,930,307 for fiscal year 2023.

Please reply as soon as possible whether your hospital approves of the proposed spending floor or will consider requesting a modification. Providence Health System has 30 calendar days from the date of this letter to request a review or modification of the proposed spending floor.

As specified in OHA's <u>spending floor modification policy</u>, any modification request and any associated documentation is subject to public posting and a 30-day public comment period. The spending floors for fiscal years 2024 and 2025 will be finalized no later than the first business day of fiscal year 2024.
