ABOUT THIS REPORT

Hospitals play an important role in the health care system, as institutions that provide medical, surgical, and nursing care around the clock, and also as employers, research institutions, and centers to train the health care workforce. According to Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services reporting, hospital care accounts for over 30% of all health care spending every year. As Oregon continues its large scale health care transformation efforts, tracking costs and utilization of hospitals is an important part of monitoring the impact of these efforts.

This report monitors and compares financial and utilization information for Oregon's acute care inpatient hospitals. Nine quarters of data are presented. The report compares the most recent quarter's data with like quarters from previous years, as well as to the same quarter from previous years. As hospital trends are affected by seasonal variations, more attention should be placed on longer term trends rather than quarter to quarter variation.

The data source for this report is Databank. Databank is a database of self-reported financial and utilization information. Hospitals submit Databank data to the Oregon Health Authority on a quarterly basis. As Databank data are self-reported, they are not audited. This report is not intended as a substitute for audited financial statements.

Kaiser hospitals do not report financial data to Databank, but they do submit utilization data. They are included in utilization reports. Kaiser Westside opened for business in August of 2013, and Shriner's Children Hospital moved to DRG status in the beginning of 2013. These facilities may not have past year data available for comparison. There have not been any hospital closures in recent years.

Types of Hospitals

In this report, hospital data is presented by four categories: All hospitals, DRG hospitals, Type A hospitals and Type B hospitals.



There are 60 acute care inpatient hospitals in Oregon. These are general care facilities and exclude federal hospitals, long term care and rehabilitation facilities.



There are 28 DRG hospitals in Oregon. These are typically large, urban hospitals that receive payments based on the prospective Diagnostic Related Group (DRG) system.



There are 12 Type A hospitals in Oregon. These hospitals are small - fewer than 50 beds - and are located more than 30 miles from another hospital.



There are 20 Type B hospitals in Oregon. These hospitals are small - fewer than 50 beds - and are located within 30 miles of another hospital.

Executive Summary

The fourth quarter of 2015 marks two years that hospitals have operated under the provisions of the Affordable Care Act. In that time, trends have emerged for hospitals. Compared with pre-ACA years, hospitals consistently have higher operating margins and total margins. In 2013, twenty-two of Oregon's hospitals posted a negative total margin for the year. In 2015, that number was more than halved, with ten hospitals posting negative total margins. In addition, hospitals have a fraction of the charity care and bad debt charges of the pre-ACA years. In 2013, total uncompensated care charges was over \$1.2 billion dollars. By the end of 2015, that had fallen to just over \$470 million.

grew 43%




2 Charity care expenses continued to fall across the state. Compared with 2014, charity care expense fell \$68 million statewide.



NET PATIENT REVENUE

Statewide median net patient revenue grew by 1% in the fourth quarter of 2015 compared with the third quarter and 7.8% in 2015 when compared with 2014. DRG hospitals continued to show steady growth, increasing median net patient revenue 7.2% from the third quarter and 3.3% year over year from 2014. Type A hospitals were down -2.4% in the fourth quarter, but showed overall growth in 2015. Type A and B hospitals both had strong year over year growth in median net patient revenue, gaining 50.1% and 23.1%, respectively, from 2014.

Median net patient revenue in millions




Net Patient Revenue is the amount a hospital expects to receive for services after accounting for contractual allowances to third party payers and for uncompensated care. This includes payments made for providing health care, such as surgeries, emergency services, lab tests, imaging, etc.

Net patient revenue is calculated by taking the total amount of money billed for patient care (gross patient revenue) and subtracting uncompensated care and contractual amounts.

Median net patient revenue grew 7.8% in 2015.

year to date median net patient revenue in millions




OPERATING MARGIN

Statewide median operating margin was down 9% in the fourth quarter of 2015, but still showed overall growth year over year. Statewide median operation margin was 4.6%, more than double in 2015 compared with 2014. DRG hospitals were down in the fourth quarter of 2015, but still ended 2015 with a median operating margin of 6.7% for the year, up 19% compared with 2014. While both Type A and B hospitals performing better compared with 2014, it should be noted several hospitals still experience financial hardships. Eight Type B hospitals and six Type A hospitals had negative year end operating margins in 2015.

Statewide median operating margin was down in the 4th quarter, but up year over year in 2015.

Median operating margin as a percent




Operating Margin is calculated as a ratio of operating revenue minus operating expenses divided by operating revenue. Operating revenue includes net patient revenue as well as revenue from other non-patient hospital services, such as cafeteria sales. Operating expenses are the expenses associated with running a hospital, such as supplies, salaries, rentals, professional fees, and insurance.

A positive operating margin means that the hospital is making a profit, while a negative margin means the hospital is operating at a loss.

Median operating margin doubled in 2015.

Year to date median operating margin




TOTAL MARGIN

Statewide total margin rebounded from a steep third quarter drop, growing to 4.6% in the fourth quarter of 2015. DRG hospitals are responsible for the majority of this growth, as total margin for these hospitals grew from 1.9% in the third quarter to 10.8% in the fourth quarter. Only three of twenty-eight DRG hospitals posted a negative total margin in the fourth quarter. Type A and B hospitals also showed growth year over year. However, despite overall gains in the groups, several rural hospitals still experienced financial hardship. Six of twenty Type B hospitals and three of twelve Type A hospitals had negative year end total margins in 2015.

Statewide median total margins show large 4th quarter increases in 2015 .


Median total margin as a percent



Total Margin compares revenue and expenses from all sources, including investments, tax subsidies, and operations. It is calculated by dividing all sources of income by all expenses.

Year to date median percent growth





PAYER MIX

Overall statewide payer mix has remained consistent in 2015. Commercial payments increased by 5% throughout the year, gaining ground lost in the first quarter of 2015. Despite growth throughout the year, commercial payments were down 3.3% compared with 2014 and 7.7% compared with 2013. Medicaid levels have remained consistent after absorbing close to 400,000 additional members during Oregon's Medicaid expansion on January 1st, 2014. Self-pay payments continued to decrease, falling another -25% to 1.8% of all payments in 2015.

Statewide payer mixes have remained consistent throughout 2015.

Percent of total patient payments




Payer mix shows the share of hospital revenue from different payer sources. It is calculated by dividing a payer's total charges by the total charges for all payers. A payer is an entity that assumes the majority of the financial responsibility for the hospital bill.

This report includes four broad payers: Medicare, Medicaid, commercial and self-pay. Since each payer reimburses hospitals at different rates, the payer mix can provide insight to the hospitals larger financial performance.

Commercial payments continue to lag pre ACA levels.

Percent of total patient payments




CHARITY CARE

Overall, total charity care was down over \$68 million in 2015 compared with 2014. Although it appears that charity care in the fourth quarter of 2015 showed moderate growth, it is an artifact of a data correction submitted by Providence Hospitals. This correction was applied to the fourth quarter, causing a disproportionate increase in that quarter. Providence operates eight hospitals in Oregon, five of which are DRG and three of which are Type B. Type A hospitals were unaffected, and showed continued declines in charity care.

Statewide charity care remains historically low at 1.4% of revenue in the 4th quarter.

Percent of gross patient revenue




Charity Care includes services that are provided for free or at a reduced cost to eligible patients. Each hospital or health system determines its own criteria for providing charity care based on factors such as income, employment status, or alternative sources of funds. The value of charity care is based on a hospital's full established charges and may be equal to the full charge or any portion of it the hospital elects to provide for free.

The total dollar amount a hospital waives may be expressed as a percent of its gross patient revenue for comparison purposes.

Charity care fell \$68 million in 2015.

Total charges for all hospitals in millions






BAD DEBT

Statewide bad debt fell -30% in the fourth quarter of 2015. Bad debt now accounts for less than 1% of gross patient revenue, down from 3% before the Affordable Care Act took affect. DRG and Type B hospitals both experienced further declines in the fourth quarter of 2015. Bad debt in Type A hospitals rose in the fourth quarter, but remained below 2014 levels. In total, hospitals ended 2015 with \$71.8 million less bad debt compared with 2014.

Statewide bad debt fell -30% in the 4th quarter of 2015.


Percent of gross patient revenue



Bad Debt occurs when patients do not pay all or part of their bill for services. It is an unpaid bill for care, based on a hospital's full established charges, for which a hospital expects payment but is unable to collect. Bad debt can include unpaid components of the total bill such as co-payments and co-insurance. Like charity care, bad debt is expressed as a percent of gross patient revenue.

Bad Debt is down \$71.8 Million in 2015.

Total charges for all hospitals in millions




UNCOMPENSATED CARE

Uncompensated care fell -22.8% in 2015 when compared with 2014. Although it appears that statewide uncompensated care was up slightly in the fourth quarter of 2015, this is an artifact of charity care adjustments made by Providence Hospitals in the fourth quarter. In total, hospitals provided \$140.3 million less uncompensated care than in 2014. Prior to the enactment of the ACA, hospitals carried over \$1.2 billion in uncompensated care. In 2015, uncompensated care is nearly a third of that amount, ending the year at \$474 million.

Statewide uncompensated care remains low in 2015.


Percent of gross patient revenue



Uncompensated Care is the total of charity care and bad debt charges. It measures the total value of care, based on established charges, that a hospital provides without receiving payment. Because it represents care provided without reimbursement, uncompensated care can directly affect revenue and margin numbers.

Uncompensated care is down 22.8% in 2015.

Total charges for all hospitals in millions




INPATIENT DISCHARGES

Statewide inpatient discharges were down slightly in the fourth quarter of 2015. DRG hospital discharges remained flat in the fourth quarter and both Type A and B hospitals had reduced discharges. Year over year, however, inpatient discharges grew by 2.4%. This increase is in alignment with Oregon population growth estimates. According to the Population Research Center at Portland State University, Oregon's overall population grew 1.3% in 2015, adding over 50,000 to the total population.

Inpatient discharges fell in the 4th quarter of 2015.

Count of quarterly hospital discharges




Inpatient discharge occurs when a patient is formally released from the hospital after being admitted and lodged for at least 24 hours. This report represents Inpatient Discharge is a count of hospitalizations. It is not a count of unique individuals, however, as a single person can be admitted to the hospital multiple times a year.

Inpatient discharges are acute care only and do not count rehabilitation, long term care or specialized psychiatric care.

Inpatient discharges grew 2.4% in 2015.

Total discharges for all hospitals




EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT VISITS

Year over year emergency department visits were up 5%, with hospitals seeing 67,000 more visits than in 2014. This rate of increase is less than in 2014, where hospitals saw 7.3% more visits compared with 2013. Emergency department visits typically follow a trend of increasing through winter months into summer, then decreasing in late summer and into the fall.

Statewide emergency department visits were up 2.2% in compared to fourth quarter 2014.

Count of total quarterly emergency visits




Emergency Department Visits are reported as the number of visits to a hospital emergency department that do not result in a hospital admission. A person that visits the emergency department and is then admitted is counted as an inpatient discharge.

This report focuses on the count of ED visits, but cannot provide information about the rate of ED use - i.e. how frequently individuals in a given population visit the ED.

Emergency department visits grew 5% in 2015.

Total emergency room visits




OUTPATIENT SURGERIES

Despite fourth quarter growth, year over year outpatient surgeries were down -5.9% compared with 2014. Overall, hospitals performed 12,000 fewer outpatient surgeries in 2015 than 2014. This reduction is likely due to the increased use of freestanding Ambulatory Surgical Centers (ASC). This is not necessarily a negative trend for hospitals. Many health systems own ASCs.

Statewide outpatient surgeries are up 4.3% in the 4th quarter of 2015.


Total count of quarterly outpatient surgeries



Outpatient Surgeries include surgeries performed at the hospital that do not require an overnight stay. These discharges consist primarily of non-emergency, planned services in which the patient is treated and released in the same day. Outpatient surgery numbers do not include standard lab work, clinic visits or most diagnostic imaging work.

Hospitals had 12,000 fewer surgeries than in 2014.

APPENDIX

The following appendix pages contain individual hospital results for the measures included in this report. Data are provided as year to date results through the second quarter for the past five years, from 2011 to 2015.

Kaiser hospitals are not included in financial measures, as Kaiser does not submit financial data for individual hospitals. Some information is not available for Kaiser Westside, as it recently opened, and for Shriners' Children's Hospital, as it recently became a DRG hospital.

As previously described, hospitals in Oregon are divided into three categories based on size and distance to other hospitals. In addition to these categories, there are two other key designations a hospital might have that can impact its financial and utilization outcomes. Those are health district and critical access hospitals.

A **health district hospital** is a one that is under the control of a formal health district. In most cases the controlling entity is the local county government. Being a part of a health district allows the hospitals access to additional funds from tax sources to contribute to operations. This access to tax funding allows many hospitals to continue to operate in rural areas when they otherwise could not afford to. Health districts may also provide funding to other types of clinics and providers.

A **critical access hospital** is designated by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). This designation impacts the reimbursement the hospital receives from Medicare. There are a number of specific criteria a hospital must meet to be considered a critical access hospital, but in general a hospital must be located in a rural area with limited access to other hospitals. In exchange for providing additional services that the hospital might not otherwise provide due to the cost, Medicare will reimburse the hospital at a higher rate than other hospitals receive for the same service. These services mostly relate to expanded emergency services such as a 24 hour emergency room and ambulance transportation.

In the following pages health district hospitals are indicated with an asterisk (*), critical access hospitals are indicated with the Greek letter Phi(Φ), and for profit hospitals are indicated with a superscript 'p'(^p).
