Notes on "option 6" and other numerator events

At the October TAG meeting, questions came up on whether certain follow-up services would qualify as numerator events for the Follow Up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness measure (FUH).

Under OHA's current specifications, where can numerator events occur? Are community-based services captured? Which provider types in which settings?

The original HEDIS specifications allow services in the following venues without any place of service (POS) code requirements: office or other outpatient services, office consultation, home service.

After the April 29, 2013 TAG meeting, OHA added a number of additional codes without any place of service (POS) code requirements. These codes included:

- 90791, 90792, 90832, 90834, 90837, 90801, 90802, 90804–90817, 90833, 90836, 90838, T1016, H0006, and 90846; and
- H0031 (mental health assessment by non-physician); and
- H2021 (community-based wrap-around services).

The original HEDIS specifications included additional CPT codes to identify follow-up services that *do* require POS codes (i.e., use of these CPT codes only count as numerator events if they occur in a specific setting). See table on the second page. The place of service range is broad, and includes:

Numerator events are not required to be provided by a mental health practitioner. Therefore, services identified by revenue codes with a principal diagnosis (see table FUH –A in the HEDIS specifications) that were not identified through the CPT or HCPCS codes can also occur in other community settings:

• 0510 – clinic

• 0521 – rural health clinic

• 0529 – other free-standing clinic

• 0517 – family clinic

• 0522 – rural health home

• 0519 – other clinic

0523 – free-standing family practice clinic

• 0520 – free-standing clinic

Notes:

Visit type 1: When searching for numerator events, POS listed in original HEDIS specs were not required. Technical Advisory Group (TAG) added codes were included. Visits on discharge dates were not included. <u>Current specifications</u>.

Visit type 2: POS were required to be on the same claim as CPT codes, per original HEDIS specs. TAG codes were not used. Visits on discharge dates were included. Strict HEDIS specifications.

Visit type 3: POS were not required. TAG codes were used. Visits on discharge dates were included. Current specifications PLUS same day follow up.

Visit type 4: POS were required to be on the same claim as CPT codes, per original HEDIS specs. TAG codes were used. Visits on discharge dates were included. OHA recommendation.

Visit type 5: POS were applied for visits on the discharge dates for those CPT listed in original HEDIS specification, but not for visits after discharge dates. TAG codes were used.
