



Medicaid Advisory Committee: Open Positions (Winter 2025-26)

Oregon's Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC) is recruiting for these positions:

- **One health care provider** (mental/behavioral health care preferred)
- **Medical system/CCO representative**
- **Consumer advocate**
- **Health care consumer group representative**
- **Long-term services and supports (LTSS) representative**

Details: Ideal candidates are committed to eliminating inequities and improving health care access and quality for Oregonians who are enrolled in Oregon's Medicaid program, the Oregon Health Plan (OHP). MAC members are selected by the director of Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and appointed by the Governor to serve one, three-year term. People from all areas of the state are encouraged to apply.

The MAC is a federally mandated body that advises the Oregon Health Policy Board, OHA, and the Oregon Department of Human Services about the operation of Oregon's Medicaid program. Key responsibilities of MAC members include:

- Attending at least 80 percent of committee meetings, which are held eight times each year (attendance can be virtual)
- Engaging in policy-level discussions about health care in Oregon
- Working to elevate the voices and perspectives of OHP members
- Spending approximately one to two additional hours each month to prepare for meetings For more information and materials from previous meetings, please visit the [MAC's website](#).

Compensation and travel reimbursement are available for eligible members.
