The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) reviews health care business deals, like mergers and acquisitions, to make sure they won't harm people and communities in Oregon.

Last year, UnitedHealth Group. Inc. (UHG) became the new owner of LHC Group, Inc. (LHC), a home health and hospice company with multiple locations across Oregon. LHC's home health and hospice agencies use numerous business names, including Assured Home Health/Hospice, Brookdale Home Health/Hospice, Heart 'n Home, and Three Rivers HomeCare. OHA wants to understand how the ownership change has affected home health and hospice patients, their families, and employees. We want to know:

- How was the quality of the care you received?
- Did you notice any changes during the time you or your loved one received care?
- Were you satisfied with how often the staff visited you or your loved one?
- How easy or difficult was it to contact staff when you needed help?
- Were the services covered by your insurance company?
- If you are a home health or hospice worker or clinician, have you noticed any changes in the past year?
