**1. Confidential Appendix, RFI #1(a): Ascension’s relationship to Regent Surgical Health, LLC (“Regent Surgical Health”) and Regent Surgical Management, LLC (“Regent Surgical Management”).**

a. In the December 19 response, Ascension states that “Ascension has only a minority stake in Regent [Surgical Health]”. Further, Ascension\_HCMO\_00377 references an “acquisition of Regent in 2021” by Ascension. Please clarify if this current “minority interest” is the acquisition referred to in Ascension\_HCMO\_00377 or if this is referring to another transaction.
