Health Care Market Oversight

MedImpact and Sav-RX

The <u>Health Care Market Oversight</u> (HCMO) program reviews heath care business deals to make sure they support Oregon's goals of health equity, lower costs, increased access, and better care. On November 24, 2025, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) accepted a complete notice of material change describing plans for MedImpact Healthcare Systems, Inc. ("MedImpact") to acquire A&A Services, LLC, d/b/a Sav-Rx ("Sav-Rx").

Who's involved?

MedImpact is a privately held, for-profit organization that is headquartered in California. MedImpact provides prescription and pharmacy benefit management (PBM) services to employers, health plans, government agencies, and other pharmacy benefit managers. In 2024, MedImpact served more than 18 million people nationwide, including roughly 786,000 people in Oregon

Sav-Rx is a privately owned pharmacy benefit manager headquartered in Nebraska. Sav-Rx provides PBM, mail order, and specialty drug services for unions and other employers and health plans. In 2024, Sav-Rx managed pharmacy claims for more than 2,000 people in Oregon.

About the deal

MedImpact is proposing to acquire 100% of membership interests of Sav-Rx. MedImpact states that they expect the transaction to expand its services to unions nationwide and to deliver more competitive pricing. The entities also state that they do not expect any immediate changes to Sav-Rx's operational structure, staffing, service offerings, or geographical footprint.

What's next?

OHA is reviewing this deal to understand how it could affect access to care for communities in Oregon. During the review, OHA will use health care data, news and media reports, information from the entities, and public input to decide whether the deal should be approved. After completing a review, OHA will issue a decision about whether the deal may proceed as planned.
