KidsCare and Therapy2000

The [Health Care Market Oversight](#) (HCMO) program reviews health care business deals to make sure they support Oregon's goals of health equity, lower costs, increased access, and better care. On March 20, 2026, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) accepted a complete notice of material change describing plans for Therapy2000 to acquire KidsCare.

Who's involved?

KidsCare, a for-profit company headquartered in Texas and wholly-owned by Texas limited liability company TMS-CJ Holdings, provides clinic-based and at-home speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and private duty nursing to pediatric patients. KidsCare operates in 9 states, including one location in Beaverton, Oregon. KidsCare provides in-home services in eight Oregon counties. KidsCare Home Health employs 91 staff in Oregon and in 2025 served 1,066 patients in Oregon.

Therapy2000 is a for-profit holding company with two clinical subsidiaries that provide in-home pediatric physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech-language pathology. Therapy2000 has 14 locations in Texas and does not currently operate in Oregon. In September 2025, Therapy2000 was purchased by the private equity firm Avesi Partners

About the deal

Therapy2000 is proposing to acquire KidsCare and all of its subsidiaries; as part of the deal, the current KidsCare management team would remain involved in the post-closing operations of the business, including KidsCare Oregon. The entities state that the proposed transaction would bring in new money to support KidsCare's goal to deliver high quality pediatric health care across the country and that the transaction will not change the type and level of services currently provided.

What's next?

OHA is reviewing this deal to understand how it could affect access to care for communities in Oregon. During the review, OHA will use health care data, news and media reports, information from the entities, and public input to decide whether the deal should be approved. After completing a review, OHA will issue a decision about whether the deal may proceed as planned.
