Amber Acquisitions directly owns all of the outstanding equity interest of Amber. Amber Acquisitions is a holding company that does not provide any direct health care services to individuals.

a. Describe Party C's business, including business lines or segments

Amber holds one non-resident pharmacy license in the State of Oregon and is primarily focused on dispensing high-cost, high-touch medications for complex and chronic diseases (e.g., rare disease, infusion, oncology, immunology, neurology, fertility, and transplant medications) and provides other related pharmacy services in the state. Amber provides services to Oregon residents as a mail order pharmacy. Amber is accredited as a specialty pharmacy and is additionally accredited with the Utilization Review Accreditation Commission (URAC) as a rare disease Center of Excellence.

b. Describe Party C's governance and operational structure (including ownership of or by a health care entity)

The president of Amber reports directly to the president of Hy-Vee, Inc. Additionally, Amber conducts quarterly board of directors' meetings and ad hoc meetings and communications with the Amber board as needed. The board is made up of Hy-Vee executives including Hy-Vee's CEO, President, CFO and others.
