Cascade High Value Network

The [Health Care Market Oversight](#) (HCMO) program reviews health care business deals to make sure they support Oregon's goals of health equity, lower costs, increased access, and better care. On August 27, 2026, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) accepted a complete notice of material change describing plans for eleven hospitals in Oregon to form Cascade High Value Network (Cascade Network).

Who's involved?

Cascade Network is a clinically integrated network (CIN) comprising eleven participating hospitals in Oregon: Bay Area Hospital, Blue Mountain Hospital District, Coquille Valley Hospital, Curry General Hospital, Grande Ronde Hospital, Harney District Hospital, Lake District Hospital, Lower Umpqua Hospital District, Pioneer Memorial Hospital, Southern Coos Hospital & Health Center, and Wallowa Memorial Hospital. The participating hospitals largely serve rural communities in Southern Oregon, Eastern Oregon and the Oregon Coast.

Cascade Network will be managed by Cibolo Health, a company that supports rural hospital CINs in Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, and Wisconsin.

About the deal

With this proposed transaction, the participating hospitals aim to share resources, build capacity to participate in value-based payment arrangements, and pool resources to support population health initiatives. The participating hospitals plan to enter an agreement to form Cascade Network. Cascade Network will be governed by participating hospitals and managed by Cibolo Health (through a management services agreement with Cascade Network).

What's next?

OHA is reviewing this deal to understand how it could affect health care for communities in Oregon. During the review, OHA will use health care data, news and media reports, information from the entities, and public input to decide whether the deal should be approved. After completing a review, OHA will issue a decision about whether the deal may proceed as planned.
