

Crosswalk: BH HIT Workgroup Recommendations with BH HIT Work Plan – July 2019

Some recommendations have components that fit into different categories. For example, recommendation #1 is split between Work Underway and Work Not Underway. In this case, this is because OHA could support BH agencies in assessing what they need to upgrade, but it is not within OHA’s role to vet EHR vendors or products. The Work Plan Summary explains each in greater detail.
