	If a provider did not qualify to attest in 2019, can we attest for them in 2020?	Yes, if they attested and received a payment for a previous program year. Program year 2016 was the last year providers could begin the program.
<b>Stage 3 Meaningful Use Objectives and Measures</b>	For Objective 7, what if our EHR doesn't communicate directly with most other providers EHR?	One option is to use a Health Information Exchange (HIE). 	Does the SRA have to have been completed in 2020 or could you (like previous years) show proof you are working on corrections from a previous year SRA?	The industry standard is to conduct a new SRA every other year. For the in-between years, you would need to review the SRA that was conducted the previous year and make updates. Essentially, every year you should be completing activities related to your SRA - either conducting a new SRA or reviewing the previous year's and making updates as needed.
	There was a program in 2018 that gave us help with meeting these measures, including the security audit. Was this program reinstated? And if not, could you suggest an entity that could do our security audit for a reasonable fee (under \$1000)? Please send us a link.	The program you are referring to was Oregon's Medicaid Meaningful Use Technical Assistance Program (OMMUTAP). That program ended in May 2019 so that resource is no longer available. We are unable to endorse any entity that could assist you with your SRA; however, the ONC does offer a free template for providers to use.
