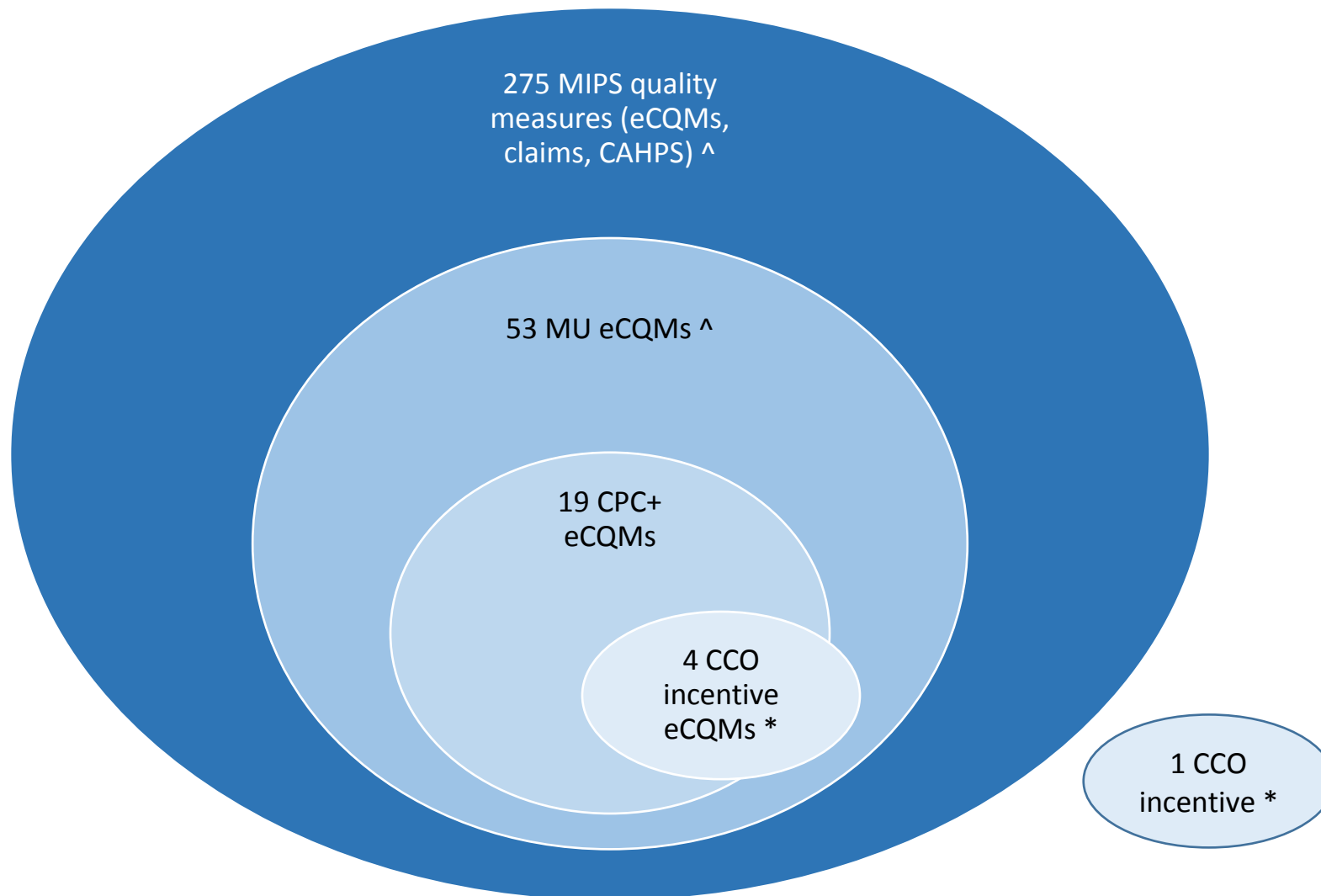

^ The MIPS and MU eQM measure sets differ slightly. MIPS includes measures for bone density evaluation for patients with prostate cancer (CMS645) and statin therapy (CMS347), which are not MU eQMs for 2018. MU includes a measure for use of imaging studies for low back pain (CMS166), which is not a MIPS eQM for 2018.

* The 2018 CCO incentive measures include five EHR-based measures. Of these five, three of these also are 2018 CPC+ CQMs: controlling high blood pressure, diabetes HbA1c poor control, and depression screening and follow-up. One is a CQM used in MU but not in CPC+: weight assessment and counseling for children and adolescents. One is a state-specific smoking prevalence measure.
