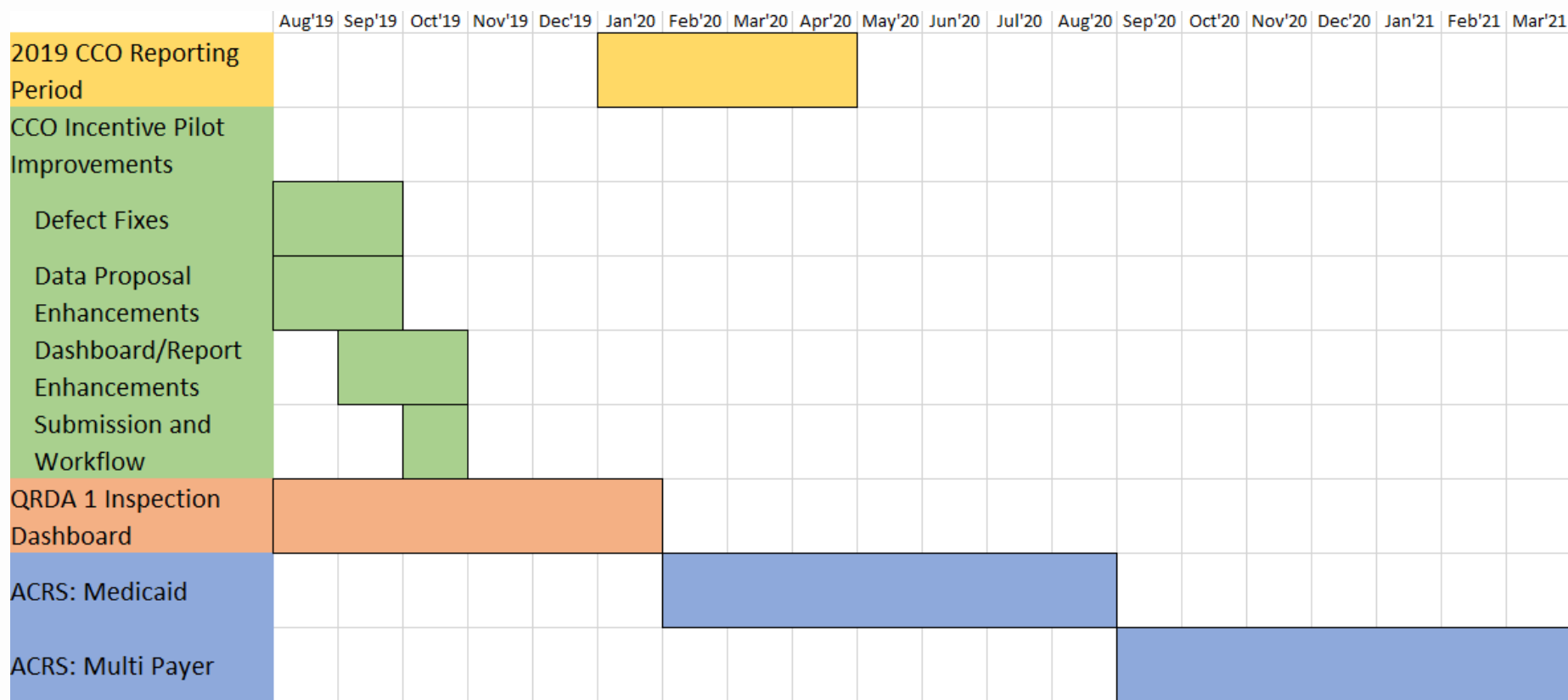

Buckets of Work

- Changes in work now
 - Lock headers and scroll bars
 - Mark required fields
 - Adding numbers to rows for reference
 - Switches in defaults/ other cosmetic enhancements
- Changes being assessed
 - Options to decrease risk of error in process to match files
 - Options to decrease re-entering repeated elements of data proposals
 - Options to decrease risk that user will fail to save data (prevent loss of data)

Internet Explorer 11 and CQMR

- Issues with IE 11 and CQMR
 - Data Importer does not function
 - Reports (generally) do not function as expected
 - Absentee Save (and possibly other controls) buttons

Internet Explorer 11 and CQMR

- Internet Explorer 11 was released on October 17th, 2013
- It's a compatibility driven solution, not a security driven one
 - Is the most common browser to have your data stolen from and to have a vulnerability discovered for
- It has bad support
 - Only supported until Windows 10 reaches “end of life”
 - Only receives minimal bare essential technical updates
 - Microsoft actually recommends that you don't use it
- It's the slowest of the available browsers
- Due its compatibility driven nature, many secure controls just don't work with it

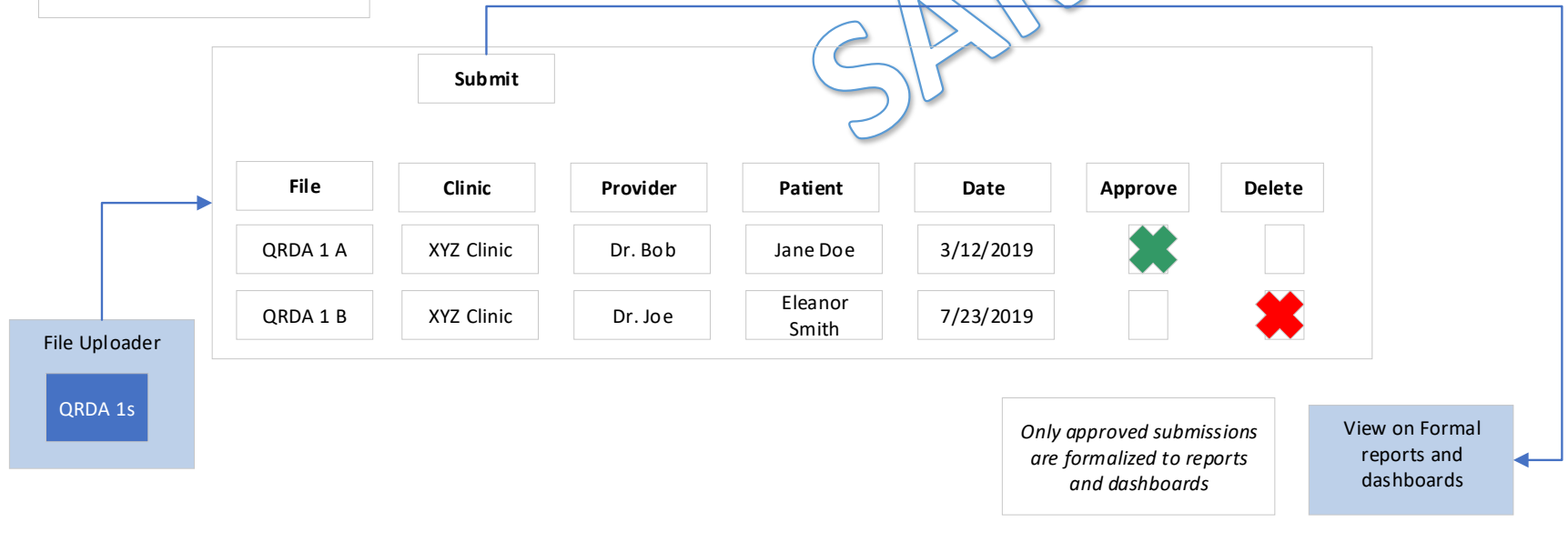
QRDA I Inspection Dashboards

- Why are we looking at dashboards?
 - Some clinics lack options to review and validate QRDA I files
 - Current CQMR test submission allows file conformance check before formal submission
 - Adding inspection dashboards for test submission would allow content review before formal submission
