# **CQMR** Roles

## Standard OneHealthPort CQMR Roles

Role permissions and organizational affiliations are assigned in OneHealthPort. Role permission sets define what actions a user may take while in the CQMR portal. The Tax Identification Number (TIN) is the unique identifier that provides user affiliation and access to organizational information.

#### Quality Reports and Data Entry + OneHealthPort Administrator

Quality Report and Data Entry + OneHealthPort Administrators are CQMR users with the highest level of permission set. This end user may create subaccounts, submit and view all their organizational eCQM data and create, view and export all CQMR reports and dashboards\*.

OneHealthPort Administrators for a CCO (CCO Master Users), are responsible for initial approval CCO data proposals and submissions for their CCO. CCO Master Users are identified by an additional administrator flag that is passed through the SAML from OneHealthPort to CQMR.

OneHealthPort Administrators for OHA (OHA Master Users) are responsible for final approval and submission of all CCO program data. OHA Administrators are identified by an additional administrator flag that is passed through the SAML from OneHealthPort to CQMR and an OHA TIN.

#### **Quality Reports and Data Entry**

Quality Reports and Data Entry (QRDE) users may submit and view their organizational eCQM data and create, view and export all their organizational CQMR reports and dashboards\*.

#### **Quality Manager**

Quality Managers may view their organizational aggregated and Patient-level eCQM data. In addition, this end user will have ability to view and export their organizational CQMR reports and dashboards\*. The Quality Manager is a view only role.

### Quality Reports (View Only)

Quality Reports and Data Entry users may view their organizational eCQM aggregated data. In addition, this end user will have the ability to view and export their organizational CQMR reports and dashboards\*.

\*User can only view the data of the organization(s) for which they have a TIN affiliation.
