| Group | Description |
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| Common Credentialing Advisory Group (CCAG) | Advise OHA on the Oregon Common Credentialing Program and database that will provide credentialing organizations access to information necessary to credential or re-credential healthcare practitioners |
| Health Information Technology and Health Information Exchange Community and Organizational (HCOP) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilitate communication and coordination among health information exchanges (HIEs), coordinated care organizations (CCOs), and other healthcare organizations including identifying and sharing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ best practices ○ common barriers to Health IT (HIT) and Health Information Exchange (HIE) implementation progress ○ opportunities for collaboration amongst entities implementing and operating HIT and HIE • Provide strategic input to the Health Information Technology Oversight Council (HITOC) and the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) regarding ongoing HIT and HIE strategy, policy, and implementation efforts • Formed by the HITOC |
| Health Information Advisory Group (HITAG) | Advise and oversee OHA's efforts in managing the Transformation Fund investments the CCOs made in Statewide Health IT |
| Health Information Technology Oversight Council (HITOC) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set goals and develop a strategic health information technology plan for the state, as well as monitoring progress in achieving those goals and providing oversight for the implementation of the plan. This includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Monitoring and evaluating the shifting health information technology environment; ○ Making policy and strategy recommendations; ○ Convening committees as needed to collect and share information. • Makes recommendations and responds to requests from the OHPB |
| Oregon Health Policy Board (OHPB) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Serve as policy-making and oversight body for the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) • Committed to providing access to quality, affordable health care for all Oregonians and to improving population health • Members are appointed by the governor • Reports to the legislative assembly |
| Provider Directory Advisory Committee (PDAC) | Advise OHA on Provider Directory services with a focus on strategy and approaches that ensure a successful Provider Directory implementation and ongoing use |
| Provider Directory Subject Matter Expert Workgroup (PD-SME) | Provide subject matter expertise to OHA and PDAC on policy, program, and technical details that ensure the Provider Directory meets user's needs |
