

What is a Provider Directory?

- Up-to-date listing of healthcare providers, their demographic/contact information and affiliations
 - Helps manage organizations, providers and multiple complex relationships between them
 - Can contain electronic addresses used to route information to providers and organizations, or other functional data points



- Names
- Specialties
- Practice Units
- Managing Organizations
- Related Organizations
- Electronic Addresses
- ...additional attributes

Why the Provider Directory matters

- Helps coordinate care by making it easier to:
 - Look up healthcare providers and organizations
 - Determine best way to contact a provider or organization
 - Find details (e.g. practicing locations, hours of operation, etc.)
- Tracks program participation information
 - e.g. CQMR participation, Patient-Centered Medical Homes, Meaningful Use, etc.





Why the Provider Directory matters


- Identifies most accurate data for each provider/organization
- Supports "report once" capability to ease provider burdens
- Aligns with national standards

Every organization using the Provider Directory contributes to Oregon's goal for statewide interoperability






Real-world example of complexity

Onboarding overview

- Two different types of individuals/organizations will need onboarding support to utilize Provider Directory:
 - Data source an information-contributing individual or organization
 - User any person or organization wanting to access the directory
- MiHIN will onboard data sources as identified and prioritized by OHA
- Users will be supported with online training materials





Process to onboard data sources

- Kickoff meeting with MiHIN and source representative(s)
- Evaluation and configuration
- Testing and implementation






Process to onboard users

- Attend/view role-based webinars
- Request account with identity verification (if applicable)
- Log in to use Provider Directory based on user role
- Review FAQs and training materials (as needed)





Help Desk Support



- Customer contacts MiHIN help desk for issue or enhancement request
- Help desk discusses query with customer, determines need, routes accordingly
 - Issue resolution requests are triaged, prioritized and resolved while maintaining communication with customer through help desk
 - Enhancement requests are evaluated for time/cost by configuration team, for prioritization by appropriate stakeholder group, and results communicated to customer
