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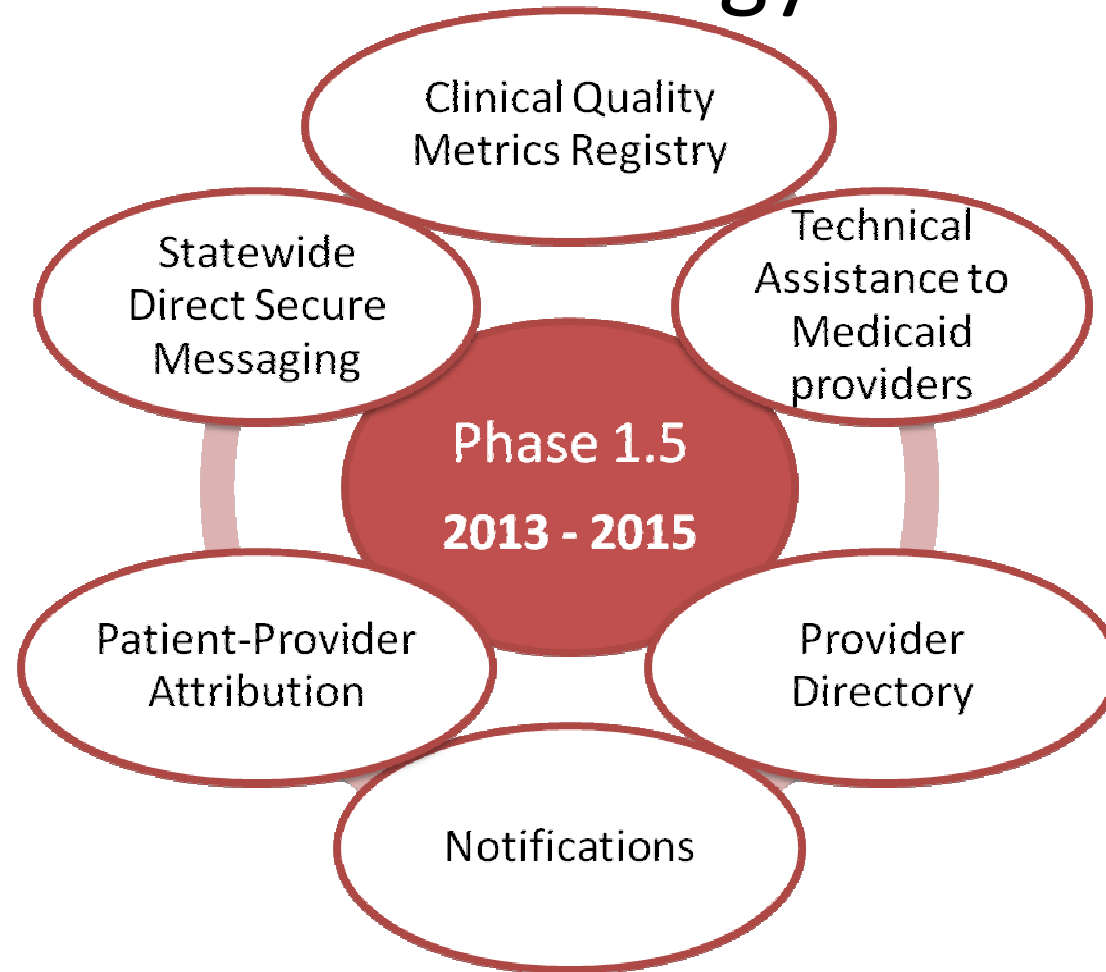

Work underway: Two Objectives

1. Multi-year framework for the critical HIE/HIT infrastructure that ensures Oregonians have access to “HIT-optimized” health care
2. Implementation of foundational/high value near-term HIT/HIE statewide services

Longer-term vision for Oregon HIT/HIE

- New models of care coordination and population management are supported by reliable, actionable, meaningful information
- All Oregon providers have access to key information needed to provide care for the whole person
 - Statewide infrastructure wraps around services that exist and enabling access to information where services do not exist

Oregon's Telehealth Pilots

- Funded by Oregon's CMMI SIM grant:
 - Consultant to provide subject matter expertise, develop options and implement selected pilots
 - Some equipment/software to implement pilots
- Two or three rounds of pilots before SIM funding wraps up in 2016
- More to come in second half of 2014
