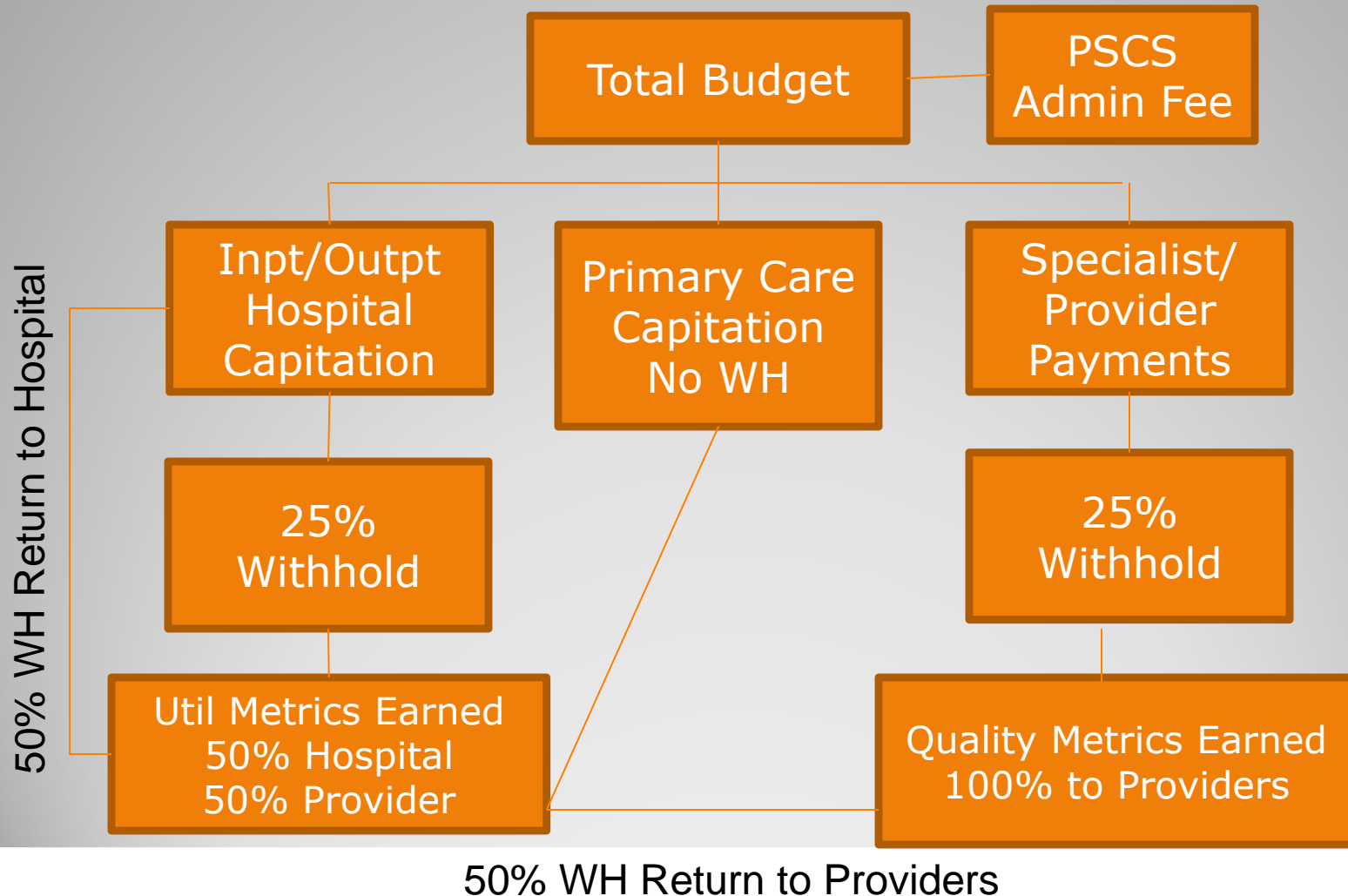

## 2013 & Earlier

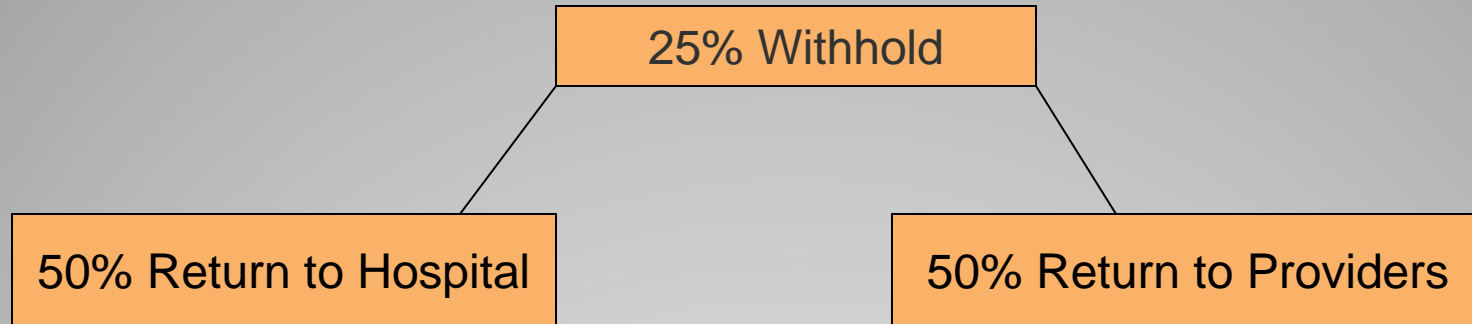
- No Aligned Incentives
- No Shared Risk
- No Incentives for Quality, Just Cost
- Majority of Reimbursement at Discounted FFS

## 2014

- Alignment
- Shared Risk
- Incentives for Cost & Quality
- Majority of Reimbursement at Fixed Payment (Capitation)/Budget

# Reimbursement Changes

## Earned Hospital Metrics

- 30% Utilization Measures (Curb Increases)
  - 10% LOS
  - 10% Readmissions
  - 10% ED Visits
- 70% Process Measures (Develop Controls)
  - 35% Managing Readmissions
  - 35% ED Interventions

# Provider Quality Metrics

## Earned from 25% Provider Withhold

- SBIRT Screening
- Children New ADHD Meds with FU 30 Days
- Developmental Screening, 0-36 Months
- Early Elective Delivery Rate
- ED Utilization
- Stage II Meaningful Use for Region Providers
