BRINGING GLOBAL HEALTH

BACK HOME

Seattle is home to many global health organizations

King County has some of the worst health disparities in the United States

Cities of **SeaTac and Tukwila** identified as pilot sites





Compared to King County, **SeaTac** and **Tukwila** have:

20% higher rates of death	Almost 3x higher teen birth rate
Twice the number of adults without health insurance	Twice the number of students on free/reduced lunch
1.5x the rate of diabetes-related deaths	1/3 of the population is foreign born

Limited access to healthy foods, transportation, and low-cost recreation options

EARLY FINDINGS

- Patients feel like they have a support system for the first time
- Over 90% are actively engaged
- Substantial A1C improvement
- Improving health and tech literacy
