Community Education

- Education for members and community at large
- Media campaign focused on opiate safety
- Partnership and alignment with Oregon Pain Guidance work

Policy and Provider Interface

- Support change in prescribing practices through best practice education and technical assistance
- Align CCO policies to move threshold to 90 MED
- Provide awareness and education to available resources and benefits for patients with chronic pain

Pain Management Modalities

- Analysis of current CCO benefits
- Evaluation of evidence-based coverage and access to benefits
- Support development of "model of care" for chronic pain

Medication Assisted Treatment

- Inventory current landscape of treatment and services
- Connect with other regions in Oregon who are also invested in this work
- Expand access to treatment, preserve patient choice, align services across CCOs
