



Reducing Emergency Department (ED) Use Among Populations with Mental Illness

Systems Improvement Virtual Learning Collaborative | What CCOs Can Do

CCO staff are cordially invited to participate in a 4-session virtual learning collaborative on systems improvement for populations experiencing mental illness. Experts, CCO staff, and CCO contracted providers will share what CCOs can do to improve care for these populations, with the goal to reduce inappropriate emergency department utilization and hospital readmissions. Sessions will combine didactic presentations and interactive activities, and will feature case examples of promising practices from CCOs across Oregon.

This **4-session** learning collaborative will include the following topics:

- **Session 1:** Brief review and clarification of the incentive metric “ED Utilization Among Members Experiencing MI,” getting started with PreManage cohorts, and beginning to work with the population
- **Session 2:** Examples of how to move from data to action, including data mining, case identification, sharing data across clinics, and data sources beyond PreManage
- **Session 3:** Establishing clinic workflows, with an emphasis on roles, responsibilities, huddles, and communication
- **Session 4:** Developing and sustaining community-based collaboration

 - Leverage data to better understand the needs of members with mental illness
 - Adopt practices to improve the health and well-being of CCO members
