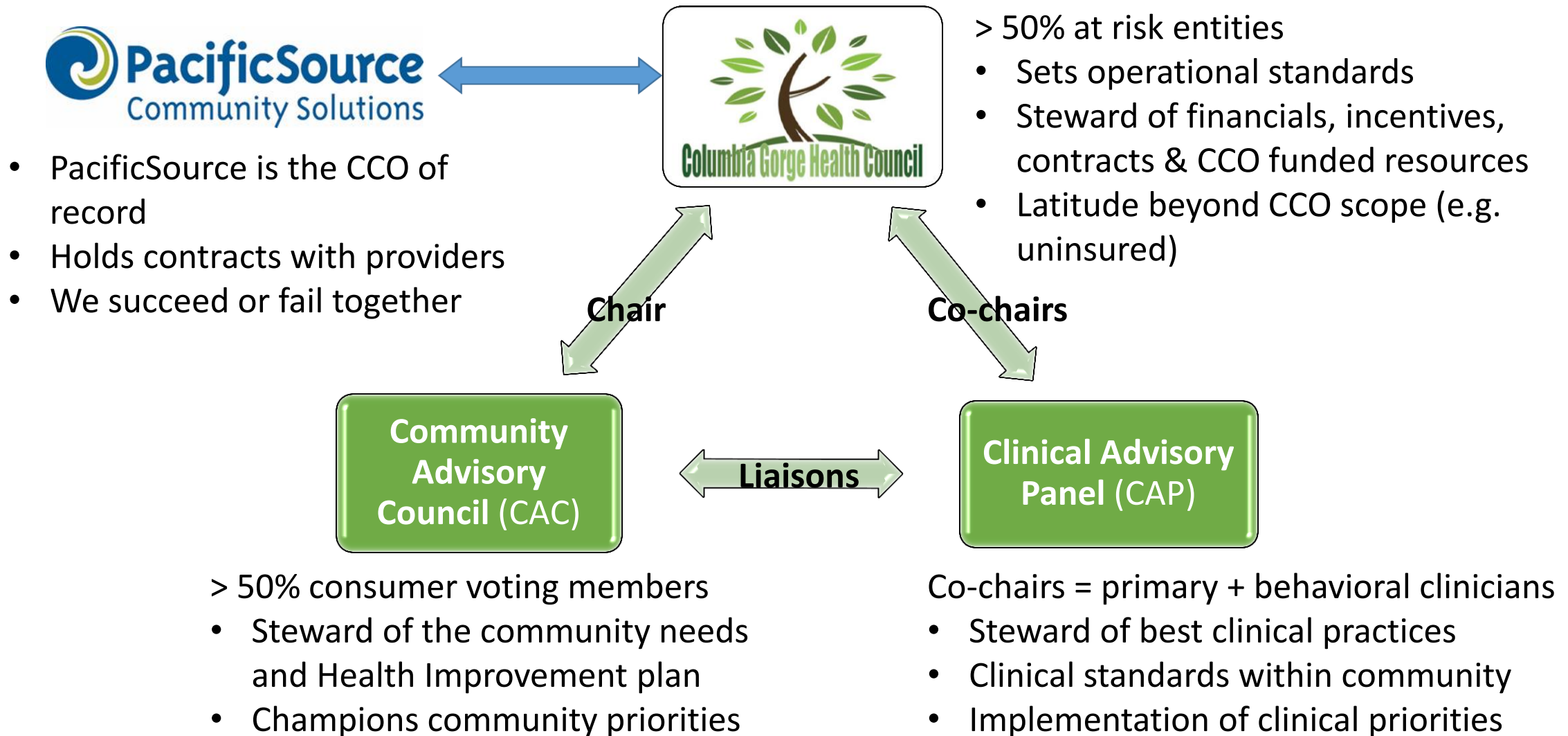


Columbia Gorge CCO Model



Community Advisory Council Overview

- Charter: Be a broad reaching CAC for region
 - Provide tangible member feedback on Columbia Gorge CCO services and programs
 - Be available for organizations beyond the traditional Oregon Health Plan/Medicaid services seeking member input on program and process designs
 - Identify topics of concern from the Community Health Assessment
 - Amplify the impact of agencies and healthcare providers by convening all participants on a specific focus area
 - Improve community integration by connecting organizations
- Results:
 - Collaborative CHA & CHIP
 - \$150,000 of Transformation Fund Projects
 - Growing trend of consumer participation in design



Clinical Advisory Panel Overview

Charter: Engage providers in the region for a one-voice approach to:

- Define optimal delivery of care utilizing all community health systems
 - Identify funding for innovative programs while reducing over-utilization
 - Patient-centered standards, guidelines and protocols for delivery of care; metrics
 - Provider development and support; Input on credentialing and privileging
 - Payment mechanisms which support the CCO care model
- Results:
 - Adopted Choosing Wisely – reduces over-utilization test
 - Adoption of One Key Question (OKQ) protocol – pre-pregnancy
 - Replaced Sports Physicals with Adolescent Well Care Visits
 - Special handling of kids entering foster care
 - Sharing results of clinical measures across clinics
