
# JHIE: Integrating Health Care in Oregon for Better Care and Value

   Oregon Corporation




## JHIE by the Numbers

- 660+ providers in more than 180 clinics
- 3 EHR Interfaces connected, 18 in progress,
   12 in planning stages
- 8 Data Contributors live, 20 in progress,
   19 planned (includes ambulatory EHRs)
- 4 CCOs live; 1 in progress
- 400,000 patients in the master patient index
- 24 million clinical transactions
- 22,000 patient queries in September

#### **Proven Benefits**
