The requirements to be a Certified Peer Support Specialist/Peer Wellness Specialist

- 1. Be at least 18 years of age
- 2. You must Not be listed on the Medicaid provider exclusion list
- 3. You must identify as a peer under one or more of the following:
- A self-identified person currently or formerly receiving mental health services; or,
- A self-identified person in recovery from an addiction disorder, who meets the abstinence requirements for recovering staff in alcohol and other drug treatment programs(2 years); or,
- A self-identified person in recovery from problem gambling; or,
- A family member of an individual who is a current or former recipient of addictions or mental health services
- 4. Successfully complete the required training offered by an OHA approved training program for Peer Support Specialist * or Peer Wellness Specialist **
- 5. Complete OHA application and send it to the Office of Equity and Inclusion(OEI)
- 6. The application form is on the OHA OEI website http://www.oregon.gov/oha/oei/Pages/Traditional-Health-Worker-Program.aspx
- 7. Pass a criminal history background check administered by the OHA background check unit (BCU)

All THWs including Peer Support Specialists/Peer Wellness Specialists **EXCEPT** for Peer Support Specialists in Recovery from Addictions must take and pass a background check provided by the OHA BCU.
