Subject: ACT Fidelity Pause

Dear ACT Programs;

The Behavioral Health Division will be pausing ACT fidelity reviews effective July 1, 2024 with an anticipated date to resume on **June 30, 2025**. During this pause, The Division will be concentrating on much needed improvements that will be focused on the resource tools/fidelity scale; admin burden reduction and policy guidelines for ACT service implementation with emphasis on outcomes. Technical Assistance support will continue to be provided as needed within areas of program implementation.

The annual fidelity reviews that would have been scheduled during this time will not need to be rescheduled as the expectation will be that programs actively engage in training opportunities and continue to uphold standards true to the model. If a program received provisional status and is due for their first fidelity review during this time, the provisional status will be extended, therefore no negative impacts to billing. Any Variances or Waivers approved for the ACT program prior to this pause will also be extended until the pause is lifted.
