

At this point you have received your Measure 110 (M110) Welcome Packet that detailed your journey as an M110 Partner thus far. In an effort to provide additional guidance on the journey, we have summarized here what is needed from Behavioral Health Resource Network (BHRN) Partners in order to comply with the policy and procedures requirements. Operating an organization in alignment with the kinds of policies and procedures identified in the M110 rules will help to ensure equitable services are provided.

The policies and procedures that are required can be found in <u>Rule 944-001-0020</u> or within the Milestone Schedule in your Welcome Packet. They are included below, for convenience.

Each BHRN Partner must submit the required policies and procedures in order to be in compliance with the grant agreement and the M110 rules. We recognize some BHRN Partners may already have policies and procedures that align with this program requirement. If so, please feel free to submit your organization's policies and procedures to M110.Grants@odhsoha.oregon.gov.

If your organization does not have applicable policies and procedures in place, don't worry! In the coming weeks, the M110 Team will be providing guidelines/templates for your use as a starting point on your journey. You can use the guidelines/templates as best serves your organization. Consider them a roadmap to guide your organization. They're designed to support you, but you do not have to use them.

Important: Given that the guidelines/templates are still forthcoming from the OAC, we are extending the policies and procedures submission date for all BHRN Partners. You will not be required to submit your policies formally until 90 days from when you receive the guidelines/templates. We hope this helps alleviate any concerns around policy and procedures submissions at this time
